

Skull Fractured in Automobile Race

Tire Came Off While Driver
Was making a Turn.

Milwaukee, Wis., June 22 — Walter Donnelly, of Cincinnati, driving a "Cino" car in a 50-mile automobile race at State Fair Park, was killed yesterday when his car ran into a fence. Donnelly's skull was fractured against a post. He died in a hospital. Donnelly was making the turn at the three-quarter post of the fortieth mile when a tire came off the rear right wheel, causing the machine to skid.
