A DANGER AVERTED. To one section of Canada the peace terms, especially those referring to Korea and Manchuria, will bring relief and satisfaction.

The yellow peril, in the shape of Japanese coolie immigrants, has been a very real thing in British Columbia during the past few years, and labor unions and newspapers have united in vigorous and repeated demands for some restriction of this food of cheap labor which has threatened to swamp the market on the Pacific coast and, in time, through the whole western country.

But the war has probably averted this danger. Japan is overcrowded and every year more are being forced to leave the homeland and seek subsistence, if not fortune, abroad.

THE WEST ASTOUNDED. The report that the Grand Trunk Pacific line through Manitoba is to be allowed to run parallel and in close proximity to existing lines, instead of opening up new territory, which was to be its chief mission, is received by the west with astounded incredulity.
