MORE STRINGS THAN ONE TO THEIR BOW New Industries Committee Communicating With Many Outside Concerns It was arranged that the new industries committee of the board of trade should wait on H. W. Barker, director of the National Drug Association, yesterday, to ask his aid in securing for St. John the chemical factory to be built by the association. T. H. Eabrooks was the member of the committee to see Mr. Barker. He was not able to do so yesterday, but will likely meet him today. Members of this new industries committee speaking to the Sun, said they were not getting on the principle of one thing at a time, but were in correspondence with a lot of different concerns. Many of these may not be persuaded to establish works in St. John, but out of the lot it is possible that some can be induced to locate here. The carrying out of the plans of the committee means a lot of work, but the members are hopeful of good results. There are numerous American industries whose products are shut out from Canada by the present tariff, and who to do any business in this country must establish branches here. The committee is after several of these, but as yet there is nothing definite to be given out. There are too, certain English concerns, cold storage and others, which are also being communicated with.

GAS LEAK KILLS THREE. NEW YORK, Dec. 21—A leak in a kitchen gas stove caused the deaths of Wm. N. Bunch and Oscar Bochrin last night and so overcome Miss Christina Busch that she is expected to die. The gas penetrated from the kitchen into the bedroom where the two men slept but did not fill Miss Busch's room, which was farther away from the kitchen, as thickly as it did the nearest room, Miss Busch and her brother kept a grocery store in West 84th street near their apartment and Bochrin was employed by them as clerk.

ANOTHER PLEA FOR A. T. PATRICK. NEW YORK, Dec. 21—Edgar J. Kohler, of counsel for Albert T. Patrick, the convicted murderer of William Rice, who has been re-sentenced to die during the week of January 22, appeared before Justice Rogers today and made a motion to stay the execution pending an appeal to the Supreme Court of the United States. District Attorney Jerome opposed the motion and became engaged in a colloquy with Mr. Kohler which ended by the latter taking up his hat and coat and leaving the court room, the motion remaining undisposed of.

COMMITTED FOR TRIAL. The death occurred yesterday of John Bell, at the age of 82 years. Mr. Bell was a native of Goddamsmouth, England, and came to St. John about sixty years ago. He had been connected with the I. C. R. freight department for a long time, but retired some six or seven years back. Three sons and two daughters are left to mourn. A funeral service will be conducted at Mr. Bell's late residence, 300 Princess street, tomorrow evening at 7.30 o'clock. Interment is to be made at Barmouth, Kings Co.

FOUR CHILDREN SAVED FROM FIRE. PROVIDENCE, R. I., Dec. 21—Four colored children ranging in age from eight months to six years, were rescued half overcome by smoke by fireman Henry McLane at a fire in a structure occupied by 38 colored families on Summer street here tonight. The children were huddled together, very much frightened and partially suffocated in a room on the third floor, their presence in the house being made known to the firemen by the mother of two of them. The rescue was made by means of a ladder and was very spectacular, McLane succeeding in finding the children and passing them one by one to other firemen outside who took them to the ground in safety. The other occupants of the house escaped unharmed. The fire loss was slight and was confined to the cellar, in which it originated.
