GRIES FRAUD IN MAINE RETURNS

PORTLAND, Me., Sept. 16.—"This section will be thoroughly investigated, and it is likely the investigation will be carried to the ballots if need be."

This statement was issued today by Cyrus W. Davis, the Democratic candidate for governor of Maine at the election Monday, who, on the face of returns from all but four plantations, whose total vote four years ago was but ninety, was defeated by Governor William T. Cobb, Republican, by 5,882 votes.

The statement was made when Mr. Davis was asked about an item published by a newspaper of which Mr. Davis is one of the principal owners under an August date. The item read: "The Maine election is still in doubt. There is a good prospect that the Democrats will not only control the next Maine house of representatives, but on joint ballot will have majority of the entire legislature and elect a United States senator to succeed Mr. Frye. As a sample of what is being done it may be mentioned that the investigation of the returns already shows the election of three Democratic representatives in places where the Republicans claimed to be winners.
