Of the late Bishop of Hamilton the Toronto Globe says:-

"A telegram has been received from Jacksonville, Florida, announcing the very sudden and unexpected death of Very Rev. Peter Francis Orinon, Bishop of the diocese of Hamilton. At the time of writing, this Sunday evening, the cause of his death is not known. He was in Hamilton on Monday, Nov. 13th, accompanied by his secretary, Rev. J. Cleary, on a trip to Florida for the purpose of his health and rest. He was in his average good health when he left, and it was with the greatest surprise that news of his sudden death was received. His people had not even heard that he had been ill till the telegram came to 'The General' Kellan announcing his death.

A brief sketch of the history of the venerable bishop who has filled so acceptably the high office in such an influential and important diocese of the Roman Catholic Church will be of interest to many of our readers. He was born in 1812, at St. Catharines, Ontario, and came of an Irish family. He was educated at the diocesan school, and afterwards at the University of Toronto.
