

European News.

The news by the "Arabia," which arrived at Halifax last week, we published in our last issue. From our files of European papers received since, we select some additional intelligence. The *Christian Times* gives the following explanation of the difficulty which exists relative to the interpretation of the Treaty at Paris:

"The root of the evil unquestionably lies in the unsatisfactory terms of the treaty. The unpleasant admission must be made, that the envoys of Russia in Paris succeeded in overreaching the Ministers of the Allies in the matter of the Danubian provinces. It is agreed on all sides that the object was to exclude Russia altogether from access to the Danube. With that view it was provided that in ceding a portion of her Bessarabian territory Russia should retain the town of Bolgrad. As it happens, there are two places of that name—the one an old town somewhat inland, and of late years fallen into decay; the other situated on the river bank, which has sprung up within these few years, and which does not appear to have been marked on the maps that were before the plenipotentiaries. Indeed, it is boasted by the Russians—and the boast gives a strange view of their standard of national morality—that they took advantage of their superior knowledge of the country, and used false maps to conceal from the knowledge of the Allies the important distinction between these towns. The truth, of course, could not long remain concealed. But it served its purpose for the time; and even now it enables the Russians to maintain that their interpretation of the treaty is the true one in which the Allies themselves assented; and that England in refusing now to withdraw her fleets from the Black Sea till Russia has made other concessions which she never stipulated, is herself guilty of that breach of treaty which she charges upon her late antagonist. And she is not without backers in these imputations upon our national honour. There are, or at least there have been, indications that our French Allies side with Russia rather than with us; and their newspapers, with one or two exceptions, are never weary of reproaching us with imputations of bad faith. Turkey herself, on whose behalf we were acting, threatened at one time to turn against us; and we were in danger of being left without a single supporter in Europe, except Austria, for whose aid we care little, and who might reasonably be supposed to be only too happy in having us to keep her in countenance in her own infraction of the treaty by retaining possession of the Principality."

The threatened outbreak among the Allied Powers relative to the misunderstanding of the Treaty is thus referred to by the *C. Times*:

"And it is a satisfaction to find, according to the most recent accounts, that our Allies are, after all, coming round to our views. As usually happens, clear convictions, a strong will, and a decided course of action, sweep all lesser Powers into their wake. First comes Turkey. One would think it could never have been a question with that unfortunate country, whether the views of England, so evidently tending to Turkish independence, were to be carried out or not. After a struggle, the Minister who thwarted our policy was removed, and Redschid Pasha, the friend of England, and as it is ostentatiously proclaimed, not the enemy of France, has come in his place. In France, also, the tide has at last turned. Indeed, it is said that, from the first estrangement was in the subordinate rather than in the head of the State. Whatever may have been cause of the Emperor's leathern retirement from public affairs, there seems no reason to doubt that advantage has been taken out of it by unscrupulous Ministers, who had their own personal ends in view, to break with England and unite with Russia. The scheme had gone a considerable length; but it is now said the Emperor himself has broken through the meshes of the intrigue, and that the two countries are again in harmony. We know not how this may be. We hope events will prove the truth of these late reports; but it will be well for the people of England not to count upon it confidently. At all events, we have had a sufficient warning of the fragile nature of an alliance, the existence of which depends upon accidents like these. We must take our own course, and lean upon our strength. Let us see to it, that in all our motives are pure and our object just; then, if other nations join us in their pursuit, well; but it is desirable that we should at all times be prepared to act alone."

SPAIN.

The London *Patrist* in an able and lengthy article on the natural, political, and moral condition of Spain, gives the following encouraging statement of the spread of evangelical truth, notwithstanding the bitter opposition of the priesthood, in that unhappy country.

The great obstacle to the prosperity of Spain lies in the influence of a deluded and debasing superstition. The foundation of a happiness of states and nations, as well as of individual men, rests upon moral grounds. Where there is no religion, there can be no true morality; and there can be no true religion, where the Church of Rome bears sole and uncontradicted sway. The hope of Spain lies, neither in her public men, though every one was as honest and liberal as Episcopius himself, nor in her fertile fields, and rich mines, and sunny climate; but in the gospel of Jesus Christ, which alone is powerful enough to undo all the evil that has been done by ages and generations of priestcraft; to open the eyes of the Spanish people to the true conditions of national prosperity; and to animate them with such motives, principles, and aims as will guide them into the right path, preserve them from deviation, and serve them with strength to go forward in it; and in the end, to be crowned with the fruits of peace and industry, to the goal of truth and love.

With these views, we are happy to learn, on good authority, that, though the change in the Government has given a check to evan-

gelizing efforts, the work of religious reformation is making real progress in Spain. In nearly all parts of the country, Bibles, Testaments, and other religious books are received with avidity and read with attention. The priesthood at large have but little hold on the popular mind; the Jesuits expected, who still carry their arts with some success, and are courted by Absolutist statesmen. The temporary obscurity is regarded by Protestant observers on the spot, as likely to issue in a greater degree and a more permanent establishment of religious liberty, than if the Esparterist Government had not suffered overthrow. The Spanish Evangelization Society appears to have zealous and active emissaries in most parts of the country, who have no difficulty in disposing of any amount of Bibles, books, and tracts, that may be entrusted to them. One of these societies—doctors, lawyers, ecclesiastics, officers of the line, &c., and persons employed in high public situations, as coming to him daily during a sojourn of ten days in a provincial capital. The opposition of the bishops and clergy is great, and, since the change in the Government, more vigilant and rigorous than before. The Vicar General in Madrid, of whom we have heard a great deal, has lately renewed, in the name of his holiness, his circular to all the bishops, enjoining them to watch and denounce to the Civil Governor all the publications of the "Propaganda legatione;" but, adds the writer who makes the communication, "I beg to remind you of our great want of Bibles and New Testaments. The uneasiness of priests, therefore, arises a much from a knowledge of the readiness with which the books are received, as from the activity with which they are circulated. If the Spanish Government would not allow fair play in the religious question," writes our agent, "we would soon have a Protestant temple in every large town." This bold statement seems to be supported by a great variety of general facts, as well as by numerous touching instances of individual conversion.

Epitome of News.

VOLCANIC EREPTION IN THE PACIFIC.—Capt. Newell, of the whaling barque *Alice Fraser*, of New Bedford, at San Francisco, reports that on the 26th of July last, a volcano burst out on the island of Oatimask, in the Pacific, throwing the water some 800 feet into the air, followed by an ejection of lava, which covered the deck of his ship. Five other vessels were lying near at the time, but received no damage.

Miss Nightingale, in consequence of her disinterested sacrifices and exertions in behalf her suffering fellow countrymen, as well as her example of Christian charity, and with a view of acknowledging her peculiar claims to the respect and gratitude of those who are engaged in kindred works of benevolence, has been elected an honorary life governor of the Middlesex Hospital.

THE EARTHQUAKE AT CANBIA.—The number of persons killed during the earthquake at Canbia was 1,970—that is, 1,400 Turks and 500 Christians. The loss of property is estimated at 250,000,000 of piastres.

It is stated that the Pope has decided to grant the long promised amnesty before the end of this year, by which the greater part of political offenders still in confinement will be restored to liberty, those only whose animosity against the papal regime is considered to be incorrigible being reserved for further incarceration. The liberated prisoners will most probably be exiled from the Roman States.

THE EFFECTS OF THE CONCORDAT.—The Vienna Correspondent of the *Independence Belge* says, it is beyond doubt, that, since the publication of the Concordat, numerous persons in Silesia, Moravia, and Bohemia have embraced the reformed religion. A paper published in the north of Germany says, that M. de N. one of the richest manufacturers in Hungary, has embraced the evangelical religion, together with three hundred of his workmen.

REMOVING MORMONISM.—The Manchester (England) *Examiner* says that at the present time considerable excitement exists among the Mormon saints of that town, in consequence of the large number of persons who have renounced their principles. One reason of this reaction is said to be the "revelation" demanding a truth of the wages of the saints throughout Europe for the good of the Church in Salt Lake City. Those who do not pay are cut off from the Church.
