DREAFUL SHIPWRECK LOSS.—A WAR STEAMER and 300 LIVES.—Yesterday afternoon were received at Lloyd's of the total loss of the Chilean war steamer *Cazador*, under date Valparaiso, February the 14th. It seems this magnificent vessel, of 2,000 tons, of London, at a cost of £100,000, was on her way to Valparaiso to construct, with a large amount of iron on board, when, on the 30th of January, being within a few hours of her destination, during a terrible storm, she went broadside on the Carranza rocks, 15 miles from Valparaiso. A fearful scene now ensued among those on board, numbering 300 souls, including Englishmen and other Europeans. The gallant ship withstood some time the fury of the wind and waves, during which time about 75 persons continued to climb up the rigging, and others to break into the air, high up on, and, sliding off the rocks, each by his own two, and, sliding off the rocks, each by his own private directions, 315 people instantly perished. Those who gained the rocks were, after several hours of intense suffering, rescued and taken in to the Coast-guard. They described the yeils of the 300 human beings, as they lay on the rocks, as heart-rending and most appalling. The total loss of lives, including the gold on board, is £250,000.

LARGE ARRIVAL OF PRODUCE.—The Steamer *Anna Augusta*, which arrived at Indian Town last evening, from Fredericton, had on freight the largest amount of produce from the river counties ever before brought by a single steamer. Besides other things, she had on board the large quantity of about eleven hundred bushels of oats and potatoes.
