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EUROPEAN.

Arrival of the "Niagara."

Seven Days Later from Europe.

HALIFAX, Oct. 7.

The Niagara, from Liverpool, 1 p. m., on the 26th, arrived at Halifax, at 6 a. m., on Wednesday, the 7th.

GREAT BRITAIN.—The Paris Press says there has been received a private letter from London, which states that Lord Elgin will be appointed Governor-General of India, and that Lord Canning will be appointed another office.

The offer of a commission in the army to a qualified party raising 100 recruits, has been withdrawn.

An express train from Manchester to London on the Great Northern Railway, ran off the rails, and over a viaduct. Four persons were killed, including the Hon. Windsor, and a large number were injured.

The subject of creating an army brigade from the middle class of Englishmen, was very attracting more attention, and it was supposed that the pressure of public opinion would induce the Government to take the matter up.

The London Globe says the Privy Council has fixed Sunday, the 4th of October, for formal humiliation and prayer, on account of the Indian troubles.

The Sultan of Turkey contributed £1,000 to the Indian relief fund. Co. s. s. p. l. importance is attached to his act in the head of the Mahomedan religion.

The cattle disease made its appearance in Kerry, Ireland.

FRANCE.—Napoleon left the Camp at Châlons on the 23d, and was at Strasbourg next day, and at Stuttgart on the 25th.

A telegraphic dispatch from Stuttgart, says the following programme of the Imperial meeting:

The Emperor meets on Friday the 25th; he will give a grand banquet on that day, and an evening party at the Prince Royal's chateau. On Saturday they will pay a visit to the Royal Breeding Stud at Hohenheim, and attend an evening party at Wilhelmshof, the garden to which royal parties will be illuminated. The Minister of Foreign Affairs will have an assembly of the same kind, and all members of all the diplomatic corps. The festivities terminate on Sunday, by a grand banquet at the Court, and a gala spectacle at the Theatre. The Emperor will take his departure on Monday morning.

The Paris Press says the furthering of a common spirit of amity and good intelligence between the Courts of France and Russia, is the only object of the interview. The innovations in the South of France have been very numerous. The destruction of property was immense, and several lives have been lost.

The Emperor contributed 10,000 francs from his private purse for the relief of the sufferers.

The grape harvest was progressing in the south, and the vintage was most abundant.

The trial of Carpentier, Grelet and others for robberies on the North Railway of France had commenced in the Paris Court of Assizes.

A telegraphic dispatch from Stuttgart of the 25th to the Times says:—Napoleon arrived here at 4 1/2 p. m. The King of Württemberg received him at the Railway station, and conducted him to the palace, where they were immediately joined by the Emperor of Russia. Contrary to all expectation the Empress of Russia will join the party tomorrow.

PARIS, Friday.—The trial of the French Railroad frauds have terminated. Parod was acquitted; Grelet was found guilty, and sentenced to eight years imprisonment; Carpentier and Grelet found guilty, were sentenced to five years imprisonment. Furthermore, Carpentier, Grelet and Parod are required to restore 4,332 shares, and Guerin 1,400.

The funeral of M. Manin was attended by 1,500 persons, including many political refugees. No funeral oration was permitted by the police; precautions were taken, but there was no trouble.

SPAIN.—Mexico has accepted the mediation of England and France in the quarrel with Spain. A conference will be held in London.

Madrid journals say that notwithstanding the ministerial crisis is over, it is rumored that General Figueras is to resign the ministry of war, and be succeeded by Serrano; and that several high functionaries at the palace are to be dismissed.

A Royal decree convokes the Cortes for the 30th of October.

PORTUGAL.—Lisbon dates of the 19th.—There was great excitement at the supposed outbreak of yellow fever, although it was asserted it was only typhus.

AUSTRIA.—A Vienna despatch says that the Emperor of Austria and Russia will have an interview at Wiesbaden on the 1st of October.

DENMARK.—A Berlin despatch says that the separate negotiations between Prussia and Denmark had been broken off, and that Prussia and Austria had determined for the present not to carry the affairs of the Duchies before the Diet, but to await the representation of Holstein.

The rumours of a French note in favor of Denmark, are contradicted.

A Stockholm despatch of the 21st says that the four estates which form the Swedish Parliament accepted the King's proposal, and the Crown Prince should be Regent during his illness. The proposal met with opposition only from the citizens and peasants.

RUSSIA.—A fine at St. Petersburg is reported to have consumed 700 vessels and lighters.

It is stated that the Russians are constructing a large fortress at Kertch to command the Straits of Kerkele.

A Berlin letter says that the Czar before leaving St. Petersburg approved a draft of a project for the partial abolition of Serfdom; and on his return the project will become law, and a proclamation be issued inviting the owners to arrange for the liberation of their Serfs.

Letters from St. Petersburg report a reduction to the peace footing of the three divisions of Cavalry of the Imperial Guard.

TURKEY.—Omar Pascha is nominated Governor of Bagdad, a very lucrative post. He is charged with the duty of establishing a line of steamers upon Tigris and the Lower Euphrates, and with the protection of commerce against the Arabs.

Three Russian steam corvettes were in the Dardanelles waiting for a frigate to enter the Black Sea. These vessels, it is understood, are intended for guard-ships in ports designated by the Treaty of Paris.

It is said that the Porte, under the pressure of events, has come to the resolution of taking the initiative in the question of the Principalities, and is about to propose an Administrative Union, extending even to the army.

INDIA.—Nothing later; but the government despatches are momentarily expected.

The Indian mail steamer Colombo, arrived at Southampton with numerous fugitives from the mountainous parts of India. They gave a frightful account of the state of Calcutta, and the upper provinces of India.

The East India Company announce that they have taken measures to render prompt assistance to all sufferers in India.

Five hundred French troops had arrived at Calcutta, from China, to defend, it was supposed, French interests at Chanderma.

A doubt had been thrown upon the reported mutinies among the Bombay troops in Dharwar.

from Cawnpore towards Lucknow; but, after defeating the mutineers [in] three engagements, with loss of 21 guns, he was obliged to retrace his steps to Cawnpore for the purpose of leaving his sick—consequently increased from cholera, and was waiting for reinforcements.

"The report of General Havelock's retreat comes by the Sans telegraph. The Calcutta 'Englishman,' of the 8th of August, does not mention it."

The Times in the course of a highly eulogistic article thus describes the taking of Cawnpore:—"It was a stubborn fight, for the Sepoys occupied a succession of villages, supplying them with exactly such positions as they hold best, but no resistance was of any avail against the little army pressing on to vengeance. Some of the expressions used by eye-witnesses recall exactly the descriptions given of the British at the Alma and the Frontenoy at the Marston, &c. The 78th went on with sloped arms like a wall; till within 100 yards not a shot was fired. At the word 'Charge' they broke just like an eager pack of hounds, and the village was taken in an instant." This engagement—making the fourth fought in five days—opened the road to Cawnpore, which was promptly occupied, though two late, alas, for the rescue of its unhappy garrison.

On the check sustained through the sickness of the troops it has these very appropriate remarks:—"The temporary reverse which has befallen General Havelock and his army detracts nothing from a series of exploits which form one of the most glorious episodes that even the history of British India contains. The interest attaching to this remarkable march and the brilliant victories, which almost every day's progress was signified, is now heightened by the sad reflection that many of that little band, which could ill spare even one from its heroic ranks, have escaped the enemy, whom they so often put to rout, only to succumb to the deadliest form of pestilence."

We cannot attempt to express the sympathy which the calamity that has befallen these brave men will excite, not only in England, but wherever the tale of their gallantry and misfortune shall be told. After having accomplished more than could be expected of them, they have fallen under the mysterious dispensation of PROVIDENCE. It is with man, however, that we have to fight, and as these few hundred heroes have sufficed to overcome every obstacle that the mutineers could oppose, and to defeat them wherever they attempted a stand, we trust that General Havelock may have been able in a few days to reach his march on Lucknow with recruited ranks, restored health, and better fortune.
