THE RECENT YORK POINT TRAGEDY.

Another of those tragedies resulting from the recent enactment at York Point. Our paper last week announced the stabbing of a man on the Sabbath morning previous to one of the Police; (as testified by the wounded, an himself.) He has since died, and a coroner's jury has found a verdict of "Wilful Murder" against him, and he now lies in jail awaiting his trial. On the propriety of arming our Police on ordinary occasions with deadly weapons, such as pistols and swords, we shall not at present pronounce an opinion; we rather wish to speak of the circumstances leading to the melancholy act which has just transpired. It is quite certain that the authorities are not clear in this matter.

The murdered man, with others was spending a Saturday night in a house licensed to sell liquor, and where gambling, drinking, and other crimes were said to be perpetrated. He was maddened with drink, a row ensued, the woman drove him from the house, an attack on the house with stones followed, the police were called, and the result is now before the public, in the death of the poor unfortunate man.

The inquiry of licensing a house of this character is too great to be passed over with impunity. Does the law authorize the licensing of every applicant without respect to the character of the premises they will probably keep? It is well known that there are dens of vice in this city that are legally authorized to put over their doors "Licensed Tavern." We ask is not this a legal outrage on the morals of the community? To these dens of vice the degraded and vicious repair; there they riot in their iniquity, and become nervous for acts of violence and bloodshed. The fact of such places being found within our city licensed to sell liquor, is a foul disgrace to those who have charge of the public peace. Is the petty sum paid into the civic chest, a sufficient price for the impure moral malaria issuing forth from these places of infamy? Is it the price of a man's blood, or the value of a lost soul? Let the conservators of the public peace stand forth and answer.

To license men to promote riot and disturbance, and then to send out armed police to preserve the peace, will not be unlikely to result in tragedies similar to the recent one at York Point. To prevent the repetition of such acts, greater care must be taken on the part of the authorities, not to cover with legal authority the existence of gambling houses, and brothels; and to ferret out and destroy every similar place that exists without the authority of license.

THE FRAZER RIVER.—The immense gold discoveries which have been made at Frazer's River, lying West of the Rocky Mountains, has thrown an immense tide of immigration in that direction. Steamers and sailing vessels are continually leaving San Francisco with adventurers. This portion of country belongs to Great Britain, and is to be immediately erected into a Colony under the name of "New Caledonia." The veins of gold which have been discovered there promise to vie in the richness of the yield with the most productive mines of Australia or California. The first colonizers of such countries are usually a race of desperate men, incapable of self-government. A mild form of despotism is therefore to be established by the British Government for the safety of the people, during the next four years. A regiment will be sent out to aid the authorities in keeping order. Some distinguished British Statesmen behold in this Colony a chain of States of English origin extending from Canada in the East, to Vancouver's Island in the Pacific, which will form a counterpoise to the otherwise overwhelming strength of the great American Union.

When the last California steamer arrived, it was estimated that 3,000 people had started for Frazer river. Now we are informed by the California papers, that since the breaking out of the Frazer river gold fever, nine thousand two hundred and sixteen registered passengers have left San Francisco alone, in steamers and sailing vessels, for the new mines. It will not be too much to say that at least three thousand more have gone whose names were not registered, as every vessel whether steamer or sailing craft, took many more than the law allows. Besides these, there has been quite an extensive overland emigration. Altogether, it may be judged that at least twelve thousand people have left California for the Frazer River mines since the 1st of April last.

On the night of June 24th, Mr. James L. Bow, of Kent county, Maryland, a moderate anti-slavery man, was taken from his bed at midnight, with a rope around his neck, was taken half a mile from home, while his agonized wife followed after. The design was to hang him; but he was tarred and feathered. He is

being, if he does not immediately leave the state. His assailants were slaveholding men in the vicinity, and the reason was, his alleged aid in running off slaves, though he has always firmly refused to do so. On the 18th of May, the Baronet addressed the electors of Hertford from the hustings. He had just concluded his address, when a lady some forty five years of age, handsome, with eyes of dazzling beauty, appeared among the crowd, and rushed towards the hustings. It was Lady Bulwer. Sir Edward's eye caught hers and his face paled. He suddenly turned his back upon the unwelcome intruder, and disappeared from the hustings, while she mounted, and then addressed the crowd for some time, upon the wrongs which she said her husband had inflicted upon her, and also asserting her intention of confronting him on every possible occasion until she compelled him to redress her wrongs.

Dr. Livingstone, the African explorer, had arrived at the Cape of Good Hope, where he had met with most cordial and gratifying reception from his friends. The presented him with a small silver box containing a purse of eight hundred guineas, and entertained him at a grand dinner. He has been obliged to leave Mrs. Livingstone behind, as she suffered so dreadfully from sea-sickness that it was doubtful whether she could reach the East Coast alive. She intends proceeding with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Moffat, to his missionary station at Kuruman, and thence hopes to rejoin her husband on the Zambesi some time next year.

On Monday, July 5th, the British Ship Grotto, with a cargo of sugar from Cuba destined for Liverpool, was found making towards Sandy Hook, with the Wife of the Captain at the helm, her husband lying below in a dying condition from yellow fever. All but three of the original ship's company, consisting of 11 persons, had died of that disease. Mrs. Dunlevy, the heroic woman, had attended upon the sick with unremitting diligence, until the fatal illness of the captain, her husband, had called her to the helm.

The telegram to the News Room is as follows:—**GREAT BRITAIN.**—On the 15th in the House of Lords, after debate upon the Indian bill, during which Lord Ellenborough characterized the bill as one of the most gratuitous acts of truckling to the temporary feelings of the House of Commons the Government could be guilty of, the bill was passed to a second reading. In the Commons the proceedings, which were of merely local importance, included the introduction of a bill by Mr. Disraeli providing for the purification of the Thames and drainage of London, the Government to guarantee a loan of £3,000,000 for the purpose. Parliament is expected to be prorogued on the 31st July.

It is authoritatively announced that the British Government would take no further steps against Thomas Alston, who was implicated in the January conspiracy against the Emperor Napoleon, and withdraws the offer of a reward for his apprehension. The London Times city article, in some lengthy remarks, attributes the inactivity in all kinds of securities to mistrust, as to future peaceable intentions of the French Government, and says the financial world are entitled to demand whether Mr. Disraeli should not, on their behalf, turn his "positional" position with the Emperor to account, and bring about an understanding for the general return to a peace standard, which may enable them to proceed in the accustomed track, and enjoy all sides a renewal of prosperity.

It is rumored that the Panama route is to alternate with the Suez route, for fortnightly mails between England and Australia.

LONDON.—Saturday (latest by Telegraph). The Times city article reports an improvement of an eighth in funds yesterday, but rather less firm at the close. The Daily News reports market firm, owing to recent bona fide investments. Small quantities of gold were taken from the Bank for the continent, owing to the non-delivery of Australian arrivals. The Shooting Star from Melbourne has arrived, bringing £164,000 in gold, making the receipts of the week £710,000; two other ships are about due with £400,000 more.

FRANCE.—The prominent topic of discussion in Paris was the visit of Prince Napoleon to the great Industrial Exhibition at Timoges, and the flattering reception accorded him there. A model, in relief, of the works at Cherbourg, is to be presented to Queen Victoria. The Marine Department had contracted for a supply of six barrelled revolvers for the naval service. The Paris papers generally deny the assumption of the London Times, that the fortifications at Cherbourg are intended as a menace. It is said that orders have been sent to the commander of the French naval division in China, to despatch two ships of war at once to the Red Sea. The French admiral on the Greek station was ordered to Cadix.

Belgium.—The Belgium Chambers were to be convoked for the 20th, when the fortification of Antwerp will be discussed.

Spain.—A Madrid telegram says that Spain had addressed an energetic remonstrance on the subject of insults offered in the English Parliament.

It is reported from Madrid that Gen. O'Donnell will dissolve the Cortes in a very short time. It is also stated he intends to divide the army into large divisions, as in France, and to place eminent Generals at the head of them.

A semi-official Spanish journal says the new Ministry is not less decided than the preceding one, to demand explanations from England, on the subject of the offensive words of Lord Malmesbury, on the question of the English cruisers.

It is stated that an expedition of 10,000 men is preparing in Spain for the purpose of proceeding to Mexico to enforce satisfaction for unredressed grievances against the Mexican government.

Prussia.—It is said that the health of the Princess Frederick William will not admit of her meeting her mother at Cologne, and that Queen Victoria consequently goes to Potsdam.

Italy.—The elections in Sardinia to fill the vacancies were generally favourable to the Government.

Russia.—Petersburg letters say the military character of the administrative system of Poland, is about to be superseded by a new system, in which the civil element will predominate.

Turkey.—Private dispatches intimate that Turks had attacked the Montenegrins, and that after three conflicts the latter had retreated to the mountains. This story lacks confirmation. A general officer of the Turkish army had been ordered to proceed to Jeddah as Imperial Commissioner, with directions to punish parties implicated in the recent massacre according to martial law.

ARABIA &c.—A Mohammedan massacre of Christians was reported at Jeddah on the 15th June; the English and French consuls were slaughtered, and there were twenty other victims. 11. M. steamer Cyclops rescued 26 persons and conveyed them to Suez. The Turkish envoy in Paris had received a telegraphic dispatch from his Government promising that all the satisfaction in its power for the massacre at Jeddah, and the Arabs will be severely punished. It is affirmed that the place will be occupied by a French and English force. Further outrages in Turkey against the Christians are reported at Athens. It is stated that the terrible reaction by the Mussulmans against the Christian, has taken place in Candia. The Catholic Church had been attacked, and the Christians were quitting the city. There was considerable agitation at Suez against Europeans, and troops had been sent to prevent the movement. The Paris correspondent of the London Times says—advice from Constantinople announce that the Porte has sent 2000 troops to Jeddah, to inflict exemplary punishment on the murderers of the Christians.

INDIA.—Bombay mail, July 19th, arrived at Alexandria on the 10th July. On the 10th June an engagement took place between Calcutta rebels and the troops of Maharajah Scindia, near Gwalior; the right and left divisions of Scindia's force gave way and joined the enemy. The centre, composed of Maharajah's body guards, fought well, but were beaten with considerable loss. Scindia fled to Agra, the rebels occupied the fort at Gwalior, and the British Government guaranteed a loan of £3,000,000 for the purpose.
