Of course they refused, and when they went home to barracks they told what had happened to the adjutant, or some other superior in the army. He informed the police, and they at once arrested the prisoner, who as I said, is now committed on a charge of having been connected with the Fenian Brotherhood. The prisoner's name is John Allan, an ex-soldier, and ganger on the Corkville embankment. It is said that a book of names was found with him. (From the Ulster Observer of Tuesday.)

NEWS IN OTHER PARTS OF IRELAND.

The Fenian panic has spread to Carrickfergus, and the old castle, which was fast becoming a fitting home for the bat and owl, has been once more converted to warlike purposes. A small Government steamer containing supplies of ammunition anchored under its walls on Sunday, and on this day for the first time these fifty years guards were placed on the mouldering battlements. This event has created considerable surprise in the town and neighborhood. All sort of rumours are afloat, and old people omniously shake their heads, and repeat the same stories right and left a century ago. The amount of the castle's damage is now quite clear.
