QUAKER REVIVAL.—The Society of Friends has for many years been in a stationary or declining condition. We have noticed within a recent period, accounts of revivals in some of their Societies, especially in Indiana and other interior States, having all the characteristic marks of revivals as experienced by the evangelical denominations, except, perhaps, what was to have been expected, and may be pronounced a good feature—more waiting upon the Lord, and less of human effort. The meetings have been freely participated in by Christians without distinction of sect, and their churches as well as the Friends' Societies, have been strengthened by the fruits of the work. The movement has spread into this State—a daily meeting is in progress in Brooklyn. The interest is increasing. Friends are in attendance from different parts of the country, some of whom it is expected will remain through the winter.

ELDER JACOB KNAPP is laboring with great success as an evangelist in the Fifth Baptist Church, Chicago. On Sunday the 3rd inst., Rev. W. J. Kinnear, pastor, baptized nine persons, and a still larger number are expected to observe this ordinance next Sunday. The Western Avenue Baptist Church—Rev. John Gordon—expect to enjoy brother Knapp's services for a short time. The religious awakening which is now going on will be followed with the most glorious results.

ATTENTION TO STANFORD.—One of the Cincinnati Methodist churches, places two or three cards at each pew every Sabbath, with these words at the top of the card: "To the visitor at St. John's Methodist Episcopal Church," and this invitation in smaller letters following: "If you are willing to receive a call from the pastor of this Church, at your house or your place of business, please write your address on the back of this card, and leave it on the seat at the close of the service." At the bottom is the name of the pastor and his place of residence. By this means the pastor has thus been put in communication with several persons who are now regular attendants on Divine worship. This is a plan that might be followed everywhere with good results.

BREVITIES.—Westmorland County is to have a new Court House. It is to be built at Dorchester, and the cost is not to exceed \$10,000. The missing man, Thos. C. Moulton, of whom mention was made in this column a few weeks ago, has turned up in Hatch, Michigan.—George Lewis, a colored man well known in this city, died suddenly, on Saturday evening. Run killed him.—A woman in Iowa has sued several rum-sellers for \$5000 each, for damages done by furnishing her husband with liquor.—A horrible murder is supposed to have been committed at Harbor Grace, Newfoundland. A woman and her brother were found dead, the man fearfully mutilated. Facts are coming to light which point to the husband of the dead woman and a servant girl as the perpetrators of the crime.—The Grand Duke Alexis has given \$5000 for distribution among the poor of New York.—Major Dale, of the army, died very suddenly of apoplexy shortly after his recent visit to this city and Frederick.—Dr. Dow lectured in the Mechanics' Institute on Monday evening last—subject, A Day in the Highlands of Scotland.—Alvin Crosby, mate of the torpedo Y. E. Hazard, was drowned at Yarmouth last week.—Mr. A. B. Simmons an agent of the Eastern Express Company, was killed on Saturday near Bangor by the upsetting of a coach. There were eighteen other persons in the coach, but none of them were seriously injured.—The cold wave has seriously interfered with the cotton picking.—The number of Chicago families receiving charitable relief is decreasing at a very satisfactory rate.—There is a needle factory in New Haven, where the whole process of changing a coil of wire into needles is performed by a single machine, which turns out 50,000 to 40,000 needles per day, while another machine arranges the heads and points together, and a third piece of machinery puts them into paper.—In one spot in burning Chicago eight thousand stoves fused, and gunpowder is being resorted to in order to melt them, and destroy them.—There are three towns in Massachusetts over sixty years old, which have never had a building burnt down.—Flea has been successfully raised in Tennessee, but the small experimental crops have thus far cost more than as much per pound as the Central America are to hold a convention for purposes of confederation.

Licenses are in force for this winter. Messrs. Wilson, Bentley & Co.'s new steam saw and grist mill at Salisbury Station is nearly ready for work. They are setting up the engine now.

BURIAL OF \$600,000 IN BANK NOTES.—On Tuesday morning the directors of the late Commercial Bank destroyed bank bills to the amount of \$600,000, which had been released since the suspension of that institution.

INCENDIARIES IN YARMOUTH.—Mrs. Fraser, the landlady of the American House in Yarmouth, N. B., discovered fire in a bed in an unoccupied bed room on the ground floor, between 12 and 1 o'clock Sunday night. The hearers were aroused and the fire extinguished. It was found that the floor and walls of the room had been sprinkled with kerosene, and bundles of paper that had been saturated with the same was lying around.

The window opening into a pantry was fastened broken, and a large quantity of kerosene was found, and a half barrel lay on the floor. There were 27 persons sleeping in the house, and his world in all probability have been lost if it had not been for the early discovery of the fire. A more fenelike attempt against life and property was never before known in Yarmouth, and it is now being offered by the merchants for the discovery of the perpetrators of this or any other outrage of the same nature.—Tel.
