**WATCHMAKING IN SWITZERLAND.**  
(From the Swiss Times of May 30th.)  
WE recently drew attention to the annual meeting of the Society of Arts, held on the 28rd current, under the presidency of M. Th. de Saussure, and are now able to furnish our readers with more interesting information.  
Professor Sorot, in delivering a most interesting report, in reference to Commerce, having given, among others, a competition that has taken place in the manufacture of chronometers. This competition was instituted with the object of testing the workmanship and precision of chronometers adopted for pocket use were now deposited in charge of the authorities at the Observatory, and underwent the most searching ordeal possible to be applied to pocket instruments of this class. The jury seemed to find the difficult question as to whether they should award a prize, excellence unanimously decided in favor of Messrs. J. M. Badollet & Co. Their firm having carried off the sole victory by exhibiting a chronometer which fulfilled in the highest degree every condition required for such a triumph. The jury also accorded honorable mention for their first success by gaining gold medals for two other watches exhibited by them. To this triple honor was received with enthusiasm and it was a most valuable proof for the director of the Fine Arts Section closed the meeting with happy and businesslike speeches.
