THE NEWS OF THE WEEK.

SAINT JOHN, N. B., NOVEMBER 25, 1881.

NEW BRUNSWICK.

Whipple's skates are being shipped to Boston in large quantities.

There is every probability that a few moneyed men at St. Stephen will erect a first-class hotel in the town next summer.

The snow fall on Saturday night was generally throughout the Province. Three inches fell at the Miramichi.

Mr. Peterson of Gibson, who was injured by the N. B. R. cars, is getting along nicely. The doctor thinks amputation will not be necessary.

A boy named J. White, aged 17, of Carleton, was struck in the stomach by a flying ball, on Thursday in Gregory's mill and died the following day.

A reward of \$600 is offered by the Town Council of Woodstock for the apprehension of the parties who started the recent fire.

Manganese of a high quality, and in great abundance is now being worked at St. John, where the ore having recently improved greatly in quality.

The sale of stock imported by the Government took place on Friday on the grounds of the St. John County Agricultural Society. Fair prices were received.

George Maher, a truckman, was instantly killed by a car attached to the shunting engine on the N. B. & C. R. R.

Eighteen tons of R. W. W. Frink's oil, on Saturday night, and carried off the cash box, containing no money, but several dollars worth of stamps and some important papers.

Messrs. E. R. Moore & Co. have recently received a contract for the manufacture of 200 tons of spikes for the Canada Pacific Railway. The firm expects to turn out about fifteen and a half tons each week.

No less than 14,264 barrels of potatoes were sent away from the Intercolonial Railway station at St. John for the Boston market during the month of October. Large quantities were also shipped from Annapolis and Lunenburg stations.

Diphtheria is spreading with fearful rapidity in the suburbs of Kingston, and in the city of St. John. In one family in the North West there are nine cases, and in the family which has terminated fatally. Dr. Bourque, of Richibucto, has nearly twenty cases of the disease, and hopes few, if any of these, may prove fatal.

The dwelling house, store, barn and wood-house of M. Moggius were burned on Tuesday night. The contents in the house and store were all lost. The fire is greatly to be regretted, as the buildings were all new. There was some insurance, but the exact amount on corresponding policies is not known.

On Monday, Capt. Scott of the Marine and Fisheries Department, gave judgment in the case of the collision of the steamer *Howard*, and brigantine *St. John*, in the harbor of St. John, on the 10th inst. The certificate of competency of John Tracy, second mate of the steamer, for six months. He found no blame attached to the *Emma's* crew.

The suspension of the National Bank of Canada, will, it is feared, embarrass the Bay of Fundy Quarrying Company, whose freestone quarries at Wood Point and Harvey, Albert Co., afford employment for a large number of men. Mr. A. B. Bonyon, who was president of the Quarrying Company, and all the monetary business of the company was transacted through the Bank.

A meeting of some of our leading business men of St. Stephen was held in the office of O. B. Eaton, Esq., last week. The object was to consider the probability of establishing a commission to investigate the claims of the St. Stephen and the Island. The most unanimous opinion was to the necessity of an Island steamer, and it is thought that sufficient stock could be raised to build a vessel of good quality. There can be no doubt that the Dominion and Local Governments will subsidize the boat when once the route is cleared.

The contract for the new Breakwater has been assigned. The contractors are, Anthony Stevens, of Hillsboro, Isaac Duffy, of Carleton, and Jordan Stevens, of Hillsboro. The work is to be finished by 1st October, 1882. It is a very important work. The unfinished work is not to be removed. At the other end there will be a pier—built of granite—about 21ft. in diameter, the top to be five feet above the top of the breakwater, and on this the beacon light will rest. The light-house tower, of wood, which was taken down unimpaired, will be used again. The breakwater will be the same length as it was originally.

The Hampshire Cheese Factory, which is controlled by a company of persons who furnished the capital stock, closed a very successful season's operation this week. The factory has been of good quality, and the cheese have been manufactured during the season and sold at outside quotations to dealers in this city and elsewhere. The factory has capacity for manufacturing the milk of about 600 cows into cheese, but this year the company were only supplied with the milk of about 225 cows on an average. Next year it is hoped that the farmers will be able to furnish milk from at least double the number. The wagon from the factory goes to the farm houses and gets the cans full of milk and next day the whey is returned in the cans. The supply of whey is obtained. All the farmers who supply the factory will receive seven cents of the whey.

A. G. Beckwith, C. E., of Fredericton has completed his plans and specifications for building a bridge across the St. John River near the mouth of the Tobique. It is intended to locate the bridge near the railway bridge and close to it. The piers of the new structure will be of concrete, and will be strengthened each other. The new bridge will be of the Arch Burr truss design, with chords of Southern pine. There will be five spans, 150 feet each, and a span in the middle of the bridge. The latter in the railway bridge originally intended for a draw. The piers will be built of heavy cedar built to the level of partial or entire submergence, the inside filled with stone. The length of the roadway from shore to shore will be 1,003 feet. The piers will be forty feet high from the bottom to the river.

NOVA SCOTIA.

There is said to be a gold mine in Halifax County which is yielding \$6,000 per month at an expense of \$1,200.

It is reported that the Hall Anderson gold area at Fifeville Mine stream have been sold in Nova Scotia for \$150,000.

The Annapolis farmers are getting from 27s to 30s, sterling for their apples, equal from about 87 to 90s a barrel.

The coal shipments from Pictou for week ending Nov. 18, 1881, were: 1,000 tons; 546; Acadia 297; Intercolonial, 1,206; Vale, 203; total, 2,252.
