No conveyance to be made in a suitable vehicle drawn

Lepreux on Tuesday and Friday of each week immediately after arriving at the anchorage, reaching China Harbour in four long stages from St. John's. Returning on Wednesday and Saturday of each week to connect at Lepreux with mail for St. John.
