

noon, and a bureau, in which there was money and other valuables, broken open with an axe; \$100 cash, and a revolver, and some jewelry costing \$30 were taken.

Friday evening Henry McAndrews, of St. John, while running along the top of a train of freight cars, which were being shunted at Sussex, fell between two cars and was run over by the moving train. Both arms were severed from the body and the unfortunate man died at an early hour next morning.

Frank Rodgers, a young man who left Kingston, Kent Co., for U. S. some weeks ago, is supposed to have been murdered near Northampton, N. H. He disappeared from a farm he was working at two months ago and has not been heard of since. All his clothes, with his watch were found. He is supposed to have some money when last seen.

Carleton fishermen are preparing to leave for the Grand Manan herring fishery next week. When cold weather sets in they will shift their operation to the north shore, between St. John and Eastport. More vessels will be engaged in the fishery this season than in former years, as the proprietors have an eye to the Government bounty on the number of boats engaged.

R. B. Davis for obtaining \$1,000 from the Woodstock Express Office by fraudulent means, has been committed to jail to await trial at next sitting of the Circuit Court. Mr. G. W. Vanvart, who found the money secreted in a carding mill where Davis worked, would not produce the money in Court, but on advice of Carleton Attorney General the Police Magistrate made out the commitment.

On Saturday afternoon Charles Horn, a young lad who was playing or gathering chips on the second floor of the new Cotton Mill, missed his footing and fell to the ground, injuring his face in a terrible manner. The nose was completely crushed in and the mouth and face badly lacerated. Dr. Andrews was called and attended in raising the injured member again. The injuries, though severe, are not necessarily fatal.

The contract for the coal trade and the sale of the Government wharf, Lower Cove, has been let to Mr. George P. Johnson for about \$60,000. The latter will be the largest coal shed on the I. C. R. Work on the contracts commenced at once. There will be a good deal of employment for farmers and carpenters on these buildings which, between them, take about 300,000 feet of lumber.

NOVA SCOTIA.

The Albion mines are putting out 400 tons of coal daily.

Ice formed in some parts of Lunenburg Co. on Thursday night of last week.

About 70 men are employed in the erection of the steel works at New Glasgow.

Mrs. Sheppard, of Oxford, N. S., was foolish enough to pick a dynamite cartridge with a pin, whereupon the cartridge exploded, and blew off two or three of her fingers.

A young negro woman is under arrest at Sydney, C. B., for fatally shooting a sailor named Patrick Farrell. The affair occurred in a house of ill fame frequented by sailors.

Hon. W. B. Vail, M. P. for Digby, has been appointed Agent of the Nova Scotia Government to arrange matters with the Railway Syndicate in England, in place of Hon. Mr. Greenham, who has returned home.

Spring Hill mines are raising 800 tons of coal per day. This is about anything in the Province, and the maximum has been reached, as new slopes are now being opened. Many houses are in process of erection.

An officer in the Artillery Park, Halifax, owned a couple of pet birds. One of these the other day broke its chain and nearly killed the young man. The guard turned out, rescued the man and killed the bird. Col. Drayton ordered the other bird to be shot.

An accident occurred on the Windsor and Annapolis Railway, Thursday morning, whereby George Bowers, a freight porter, was jammed between a freight car and a passenger car, sustaining injuries which resulted in his death. A young man named McLean met with a similar mishap and had to have his leg amputated. Cows on the track were the cause of the accident, the engine and train being thrown from the rails.

While Miss Potter, daughter of Alfred M. Potter, storekeeper of Yarmouth, N. S., was proceeding home on Tuesday evening about nine o'clock, accompanied by Miss Bland and Mr. C. B. Bland, the latter carrying her cash box, the party was attacked by two ruffians. Mr. Bland was knocked down and the box, containing about \$300, was wrested from him. The lady screamed and help, but the villains escaped with their plunder. There is no clue to the identity or whereabouts of the robbers.

Passengers by the Empress on Saturday night, reported that the barkentine George E. Corbett had arrived at Digby with yellow fever on board. The vessel went from New York to Demarest, thence to Kingston, J. A., and Digby. On the voyage from Jamaica yellow fever developed. The master, Capt. Atwood, died most of the crew were prostrated, and were barely able to get to Digby, where they cast anchor off the light on Saturday morning. The captain had died just before getting to port. A volunteer crew under command of Capt. Bartlett, of the sloop, was sent on board to take charge of the vessel. - Globe.

It has been stated that Captain Atwood, of the barkentine "George E. Corbett," died of small pox, when the vessel was in port at Pictou, on the voyage from Jamaica to Annapolis, and that the crew were down, we telegraphed to a friend in Annapolis yesterday to make enquiries and report. Last evening we received the following:-

ANAPOLIS, N. S., Sept. 25.—From owners and the doctor I learn as follows:—The barkentine "George E. Corbett" left Jamaica on Aug. 29th, all well. Capt. Kenneth Atwood took a heavy cold, accompanied by some fever, and died on the 29th inst. He was buried at sea on the 22nd. All the crew are well. No proof exists of any contagious disease. There certainly is no small pox. - Sun.

Recent Halifax papers give an account of two men named Burr, who got into trouble in Colchester County, Nova Scotia, in attempting to escape from a contract with the military. They are mentioned in the despatches as Boston men, but they are natives of Truro, N. S., where their trial is shortly to come off, and Oliver Burr will be remembered by many in St. John. Oliver Burr was in the employ of Mr. James Harris, of Portland, in the capacity of man servant, and became a rather well known character around town, being somewhat inclined to be what is called in vulgar parlance a "sport" and a flashy dresser. His blind brother Henniger came to come and hide out in the city, and the pair received the nick-name of "Middy and Sanky." Oliver was eventually dismissed from Mr. Harris' service, and one day disappeared, leaving some mourning creditors behind him.

ENGLISH AND FOREIGN.

ALEXANDRIA, Sept. 23.—The British troops have occupied Damietta. On their arrival the negro garrison instead of surrendering, fled, taking, besides plunder, a quantity of arms and ammunition. They implicated in the Jane massacre here were hanged to-day. It is officially announced from Jeddah that the Sheriff of Mecca has been deposed and imprisoned at Taif, where Midhat Pasha was a prisoner. Abdullah Africano has been named Grand Sheriff. He is a brother to the Sheriff who was murdered some time ago, as was then supposed, by orders from the Sultan because he was favorable to the British.

DAMMETH, Sept. 25.—Abdullah Pasha, Suleiman Bey and a number of his associates have been sent to Cairo as prisoners of war.

CAIRO, Sept. 25.—Among Arabi's papers are written orders of service from French, German and Russian officers, which were all declined.

LOHORE, Sept. 25.—The British troops for the success of the British troops in Egypt were given in the churches in London and the provinces yesterday.

CAIRO, Sept. 25.—The Khedive yesterday evening drove for an hour through the illuminated streets and was well received. The Khedive will bestow upon General Wolcott the Grand Cord of the Order of Osman.

CAIRO, Sept. 27.—The Ministers met in Council to-day and agreed upon the wording of the three decrees, which the Khedive will sign tomorrow. The first institutes a special commission for the prosecution of all acts of rebellion committed by the military or without waiting sign formal order, consist of nine members, and will be under the presidency of Ismail Bey. The second orders that a court martial with eight members, Rouff Pasha presiding, shall be without waiting sign formal order, and will be under the presidency of Ismail Bey. The third directs the assembling in Alexandria of another court martial to try all cases of Alexandria and Tanah. The proceedings in both courts martial will be public and the accused will be permitted to employ counsel.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Sept. 27.—Baker Pasha tendered his resignation of the post of aide de camp to the Sultan, and without waiting sign formal order, acceptance started for Egypt to reorganize the Egyptian forces.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Sept. 24.—The Sultan has ordered the immediate surrender to Greece of the whole frontier fixed by the International Commission.

DUBLIN, Sept. 25.—Mr. Dillon, in a letter announcing his retirement from Parliament, attributes the step to ill-health, and says it will not be possible for him to take any part in Irish politics for the next five years.

The military and police of the county Mayo evicted fifty families during the last few days in the barony of Ennis, and people have been ordered to leave their homes.

CAPE TOWN, Sept. 26.—The small-pox is raging here worse than ever. There have been 2,000 cases thus far, mostly natives, of which 600 proved fatal.

TEHRAN, Sept. 26.—Near Kairwan recently a band of marauders attacked a party of soldiers belonging to the French Topographical Expedition. The French commander was killed and seven of his men died. The brigands lost thirty killed and fifty wounded.
