On Tuesday evening last, before dark, a barn belonging to Mr. Chas. Smith, lumberman, was burned to the ground with all its contents. The barn stood near Hayes, in Campbell, and was built about a year ago. It was used as a storehouse for lumber, tools, and supplies, as well as for a barn. The origin of the fire is not exactly known. Loss, nearly \$1,000.

News has reached us of the sudden death of Miss Ruth Risteen, a sister of Mr. Jos. Risteen, of Fredericton. She was found dead in bed at her residence at Jacksonville, Carlton County. The deceased was about 50 years of age. Death no doubt resulted from heart disease. Miss Risteen was also sister of Mr. John C. Risteen, of Amesbury Massachusetts, and of Senator Fred S. Risteen, of Boston.

An early hour Monday morning fire was discovered in the barns in course of construction in Titus' shop at St. Paul, the vessel was totally consumed, the stern post alone being left standing. She was about 135 feet long and was being built by Mr. Titus on speculation. The loss will be a very heavy one, but is fully covered by marine, Mr. Geo. E. Fairweather holding a risk in his office of \$2,500 on the vessel and \$700 on material.

Tuesday evening a carriage containing Mrs. Foster Macfarlane, two daughters and driver, named Stackhouse, while returning from the city and approaching the railway crossing near the Asylum, was struck and killed by the train. The horse taking flight from the wheels of the engine became unmanageable and backed the carriage into a deep ditch on the road side, overturning it. The carriage was a complete wreck. The ladies were somewhat hurt.

Mr. David Kinney's house at Grand Falls took fire and was entirely destroyed before the flames were extinguished. The fact that a quantity of inflammable material was found on the premises points conclusively to an act of incendiarism, though as Mr. Kidney was an old and respectable member of the village it is difficult to conjecture the motives of the criminal, unless it were that of wanton mischief. Mr. Kidney is present on Brussels street in this city.

*The Globe* says, an accident, which fortunately was not of serious consequences occurred on the Grand Standard Hall on Saturday morning, about 11 o'clock. About two miles from Leopre station a portion of the road-bed had been washed away, and it being impossible to stop the train the engineer ran over the place at full speed, causing the train to go safely over, but the tender sank down 1 1/2 feet, and the engine ran into the side of the train, so that the passengers were almost shaken, nobody was seriously hurt, and the line is open for traffic again.

Whitehead, and Mr. Keith, of Haverton, left for Fredericton to negotiate for the directors of the proposed Central Railway respecting the terminus of that road. An officer from Watertown, Mass., went over from St. John by steamer to Digby Wednesday, to bring Americans away under the Extradition Act. He returned to St. John Saturday evening.
