### NEW BRUNSWICK.

A serious fight occurred on Wednesday near Uxalady, W. T., between Indians and whites. Ten Indians and a number of whites were involved in trouble. Two drunken Indians made a murderous attack upon the whites, and the whites were quickly disarmed and one killed almost to death. The other Indian was also badly hurt. More Indians interfered, when all the whites came to the rescue of their countrymen. Weapons were drawn and shots exchanged, one man being wounded. The Indians embarked in a desperate attempt to escape, but were defeated and taken to the knife. Both of the Indians will probably die. Efforts are being made to pacify the country.

An explosion occurred in the giant powder works of J. O. B. Brunell, on Bellevue Street, St. John, N. B., on Monday last. The workmen were thawing out a tub containing 26 lbs. of nitro glycerine and set it on fire. The men threw a bucket of water on the tub, and the explosion occurred. The explosion was terrific. The loss to the proprietor was about \$10,000.
