**SEALED TENDERS** addressed to the Postmaster General, will be received at Ottawa, until noon, on 19th August, for the conveyance of Her Majesty's mails, on proposed contract for four years, three times per week each way, in summer, and twice per week each way, in winter, between Grand Manan and Seal Cove, from the 1st October next.

The conveyance to be made in a suitable vehicle, drawn by one or more horses. The mails to leave Grand Manan post office, from 1st May to 1st November, on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday of each week, as soon as practicable after the arrival of the mail steamer, reaching Seal Cove in two hours and thirty minutes after despatch. Returning, to leave Seal Cove on same days, after remaining there one hour, reaching Grand Manan post office in two hours and thirty minutes after despatch.

From 1st November to 1st May, to leave Grand Manan post office on Wednesday and Saturday of each week, from 1st May to 1st November, on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday of each week, reaching Seal Cove in two hours and thirty minutes after despatch. Returning, to leave Seal Cove on same days, after remaining there one hour, reaching Grand Manan post office, in two hours and thirty minutes after despatch.
