INTERNATIONAL LESSON.

Fourth Quarter-Lesson VI. - Nov. 9.

JESUS BEFORE PILATE AND HEROD. - Luke 23: 1-12.

GOLDEN TEXT. - Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this man.

JESUS BROUGHT TO PILATE FOR HIS SENTENCE. And the whole multitude of them arose. The large number of the members of the Sanhedrin, accompanied by a crowd of the people.

Pontius Pilate, a Roman knight, was made governor of Judea toward the close of A. D. 26. He was sceptical, cold, and cruel; arbitrary in his acts, and cherishing no feelings but those of contempt for the religion of Israel.

Pilate's Interview with the Jews outside the Judgment Hall. The Accusation. The Jews, when they brought Jesus to Pilate, carefully suppressed the charge of blasphemy on which they had condemned him to death.

Herod's Mockery of Jesus. - And Herod with his men of war set him at naught (treated him with contempt) and mocked him, by words and by actions.

Herod's Private Conference with Jesus. - And Pilate asked him saying, Art thou the King of the Jews? The word "thou" stands in the original at the head of the sentence, as if Pilate would say, "Thou, - thou so humbled, despised, handed over to me as a malefactor, - art thou the King of the Jews?"

This is not to be taken as a doubtless answer, but as a strong affirmation. He acknowledges that he is king. But his kingdom was the kingdom of the truth, a spiritual kingdom.

Public Acquittal of Jesus. - I find no fault in this man. His was the one life in all the world's history in which there was no flaw, no blemish. He never did a wrong thing, nor spoke a wrong word, nor cherished a wrong thought.

Training the Memory.

A gentleman who, during his business career, was noted for his fine memory for the punctuality to the minute with which he kept his engagements, and for the ease and accuracy with which he could detail the various items of business which had been or were to be attended to, assured the writer that when he began his apprenticeship he had a wretched memory.

His father told him at the dinner-table to do a certain thing, or to go on an errand, almost before he had closed the door he would either forget the matter altogether, or find himself unable to recall some of its important particulars.

His method was this: When he recalled something which he ought to have done and had forgotten, he compelled himself to go and do it immediately, no matter at how much expense of pleasure or convenience.

Many times, when comfortably settled to read or study, he forced himself - and at first considerable force was often necessary - to rise and do something he had till then forgotten.

Certainly the discipline was effective. His memory became almost a wonder to himself and was the envy of others. He kept no memorandum book; his engagements were more numerous than fall to the lot of many persons, even of busy men, extending in point of locality all over Great Britain and to several points on the continent, and in point of time, from engagements daily to appointments made weeks in advance; but he had to blame himself for forgetting only one important thing in the course of many years.
