

Bethany. Where. In the upper room in Jerusalem, a large room like a hall, used for special purposes. It was doubtless the room where the disciples were when Jesus appeared to them after his resurrection.

How long. Here they remained from the ascension, 40 days after the resurrection, till Pentecost, 50 days after the Passover, counting from Saturday before Christ's resurrection. Thus the time would be about ten days.

What doing. In prayer and supplication because, although the gift was promised, the way to the blessing was through prayer. The promise encouraged not idleness and inactivity, but earnestness in prayer.
