

### RAILROADS AND STEAMBOATS

RATES FOR TRAVELLING TO AND FROM THE ALLIANCE AND CAMP MEETING AT BEULAH, FROM JUNE 23rd TO JULY 15th, 1913.

Those coming from any point in the United States will buy a return ticket to the nearest station in New Brunswick on the C. P. R. and then buy a one way first class ticket from that station to St. Mary's, Fredericton or St. John, as they wish, obtaining, at the same time, a STANDARD CERTIFICATE which, when signed by the Secretary at Beulah, will entitle the holder to be returned at ONE-THIRD first class fare.

I. C. R.—Purchase one-way First Class Ticket to St. John, obtaining STANDARD CERTIFICATE at the same time, which when signed by the Secretary at Beulah will entitle you to a free return ticket from St. John.

C. P. R.—Purchase a First Class Ticket to St. Mary's, Fredericton or St. John, as you wish, obtaining at the same time a STANDARD CERTIFICATE, which when signed by the Secretary at Beulah, will entitle you to be returned at ONE-THIRD First Class Fare.

D. A. R.—Purchase one-way First Class Ticket to St. John, obtaining STANDARD CERTIFICATE at the same time, which when signed by the Secretary at Beulah, will entitle you to a free return ticket from St. John.

ST. JOHN RIVER STEAMERS. "D. J. PURDY" and "VICTORIA" from Fredericton, and the "D. J. PURDY," "MAJESTIC" and "VICTORIA" from St. John:—Pay your fare to Beulah Camp Ground, Brown's Flats, and then get a certificate from the Sec-

retary at Beulah which will give you a free return on THESE steamers.

GRAND MANAN STEAMER.—Pay your fare to St. John and obtain a certificate from the Secretary at Beulah which will return you free.

NOTE.—BE SURE when purchasing your ticket on the RAILWAYS to ask for a STANDARD CERTIFICATE. You do not get any ticket on the STEAMERS, as you pay your fare ONE WAY.


BE CAREFUL TO OBSERVE ALL THE DIRECTIONS, as there will be no refund of fare.


