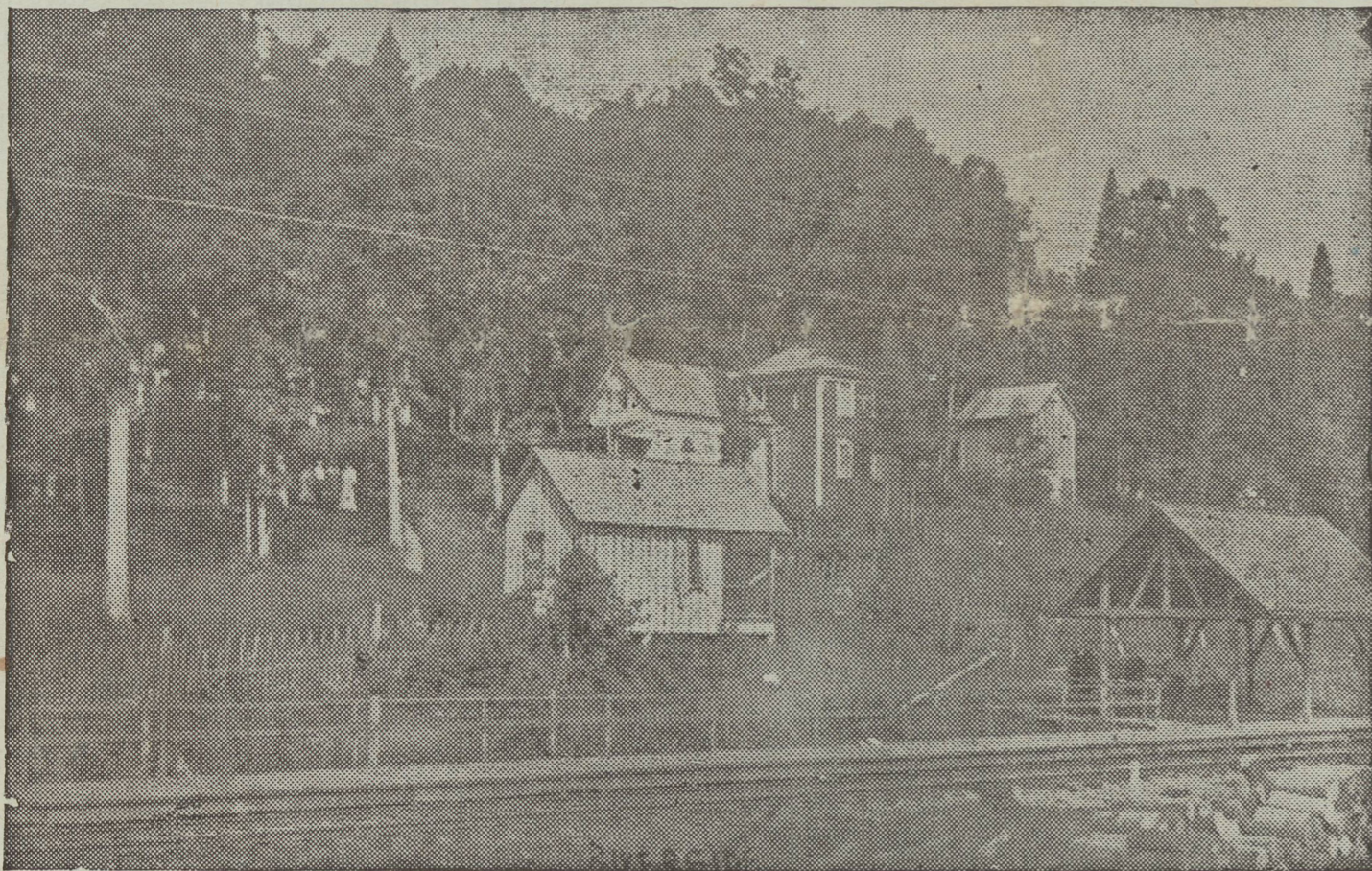

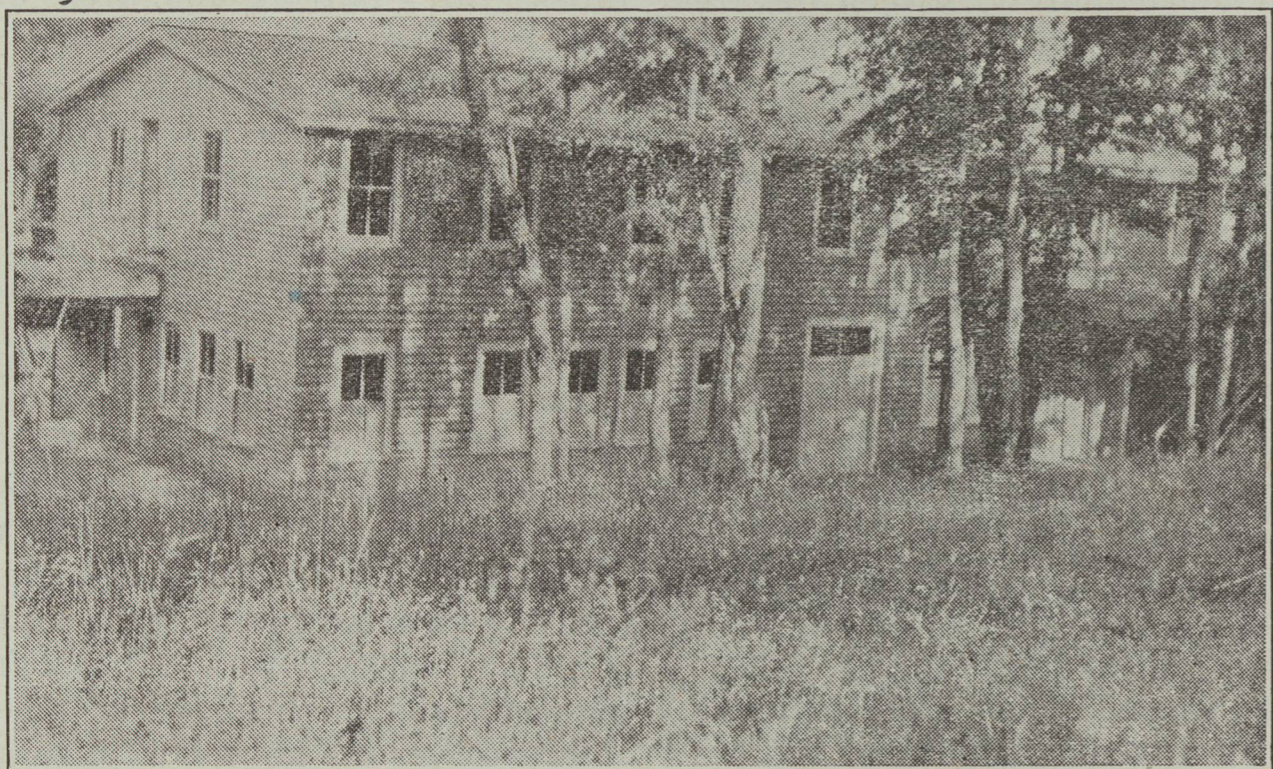

THE FIRST CHRISTIAN CAMP MEETING.

"In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness."—Matt. 3-4.

This was the first Christian Camp Meeting, but the Lord Jesus Christ held many of them during his ministry on earth.

This camp meeting was announced over 700 years before it took place, Isa. 40-3, and even the text was given, "Prepare ye the way of the Lord. Make his paths straight." So we have good grounds to call it a holiness camp meeting devoted to teaching the two works of divine grace—repentance and the baptism with the Holy Ghost and fire.

Wherein does a camp meeting differ from any other evangelistic meeting?

1st. The place—it was held in the wilderness. Taking the people away from home cares and duties. They camped during the services. Then they were away from all other attractions and distractions.

2nd. They had a special preacher that differed somewhat from the usual clerical type.

A new man, a new voice, a new method of working; an old theme put in a new way.

3rd. The message—Direct, definite, personal—Repent now; believe now, receive now, obey now.

4th. There was a large gathering. "There went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judea, and all the regions round about Jordan." and they had a big revival and baptism.

5th. The preaching produced conviction and repentance and confession of sins.

6th. A special message, a lot of religious folks were told the truth about themselves. This fearless preacher told them they were a generation of vipers and asked

"Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong. Let all things be done in love."
