Dear Friends:

What are we doing? Plodding on in the good old way. Striving to enlighten those who sit in heathen darkness, endeavoring to help the seekers to find their way to God, helping those who are saved to go farther and to understand the word and its deeper truths, feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, etc., too numerous to mention because so much is only small things, but they too help to fill up the swift flying hours of a busy day in a busy life of the missionary.

Our own children must also be taught, their feet guided in the right way and they themselves warned against the many evils of the day.

I can see the change in these whom Christ has saved and it is a joy to lead them on into the deeper truths such as how to pray so as to get direct answers. Can we know we are right with God? All the evangelists are doing good work and God's blessing is upon us. South Africa has had a hard season. Hail and heavy storms have swept crops away in certain sections and now the army worm has appeared in such swarms as to sweep every green thing before them, such as forage (wheat, oats and barley), grass especialy planted for stock in winter. Numerous sections in Natal, Transvaal and Orange Free State have been visited by this pest—one field of 60 acres of wheat swept clean. One field of 40 acres forage gone. Some farmers saved their crops by rushing out their mowing machines and cutting down the forage before the worm got there. They are now grounding but will awake soon as millions of moths and next season we may have a plague of army worms in earnest.

So far our section of country has been kept from destruction, especially this farm and those near it, but some of our neighbors lost corn and fruit in a big hail storm that just swept by us. Surely God's wings are a sure hiding place. Lightening struck a bunch (clump) of banana trees just by a little gate not more than three or four yards from the house. It was a deafening report with such dazzling lightening but He kept us safely, for which we thank Him.
