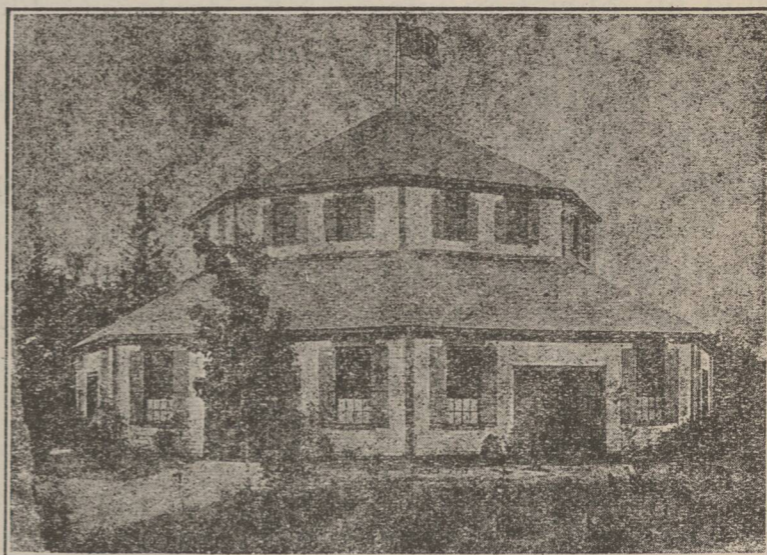

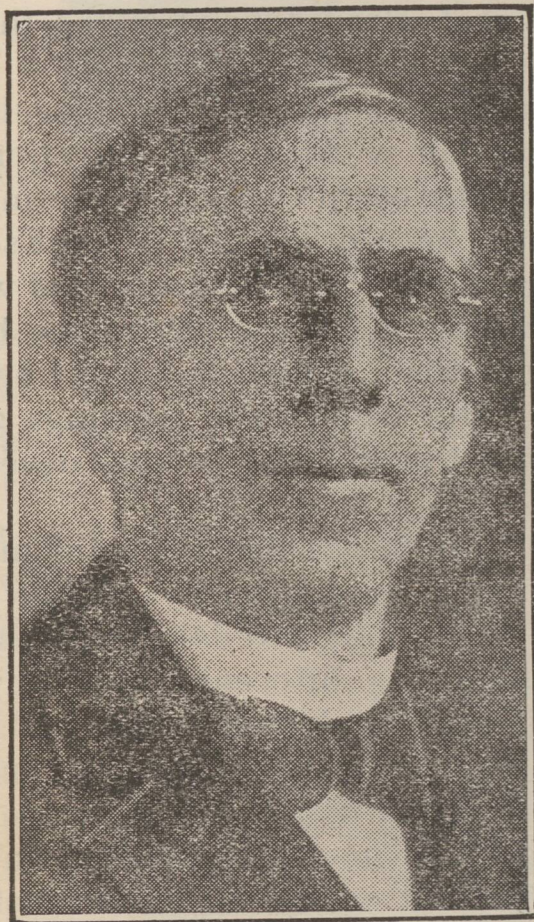


Beulah Tabernacle
