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HOW GOD ISS USING HITLER

Why Hitler? Why Japan? Why the bombs over London? Why gutted Warsaw? Why ravaged Rotterdam? Why Pearl Harbor? Why tens of millions under arms? Why the shadow of death covering an entire earth? Why hunger, nakedness, pestilence, concentration camps, confiscation of honestly accumulated property, why Chekas, Gestapos? History firmly, inexorably, inescapably answers these quesstions.

Infidelity swept the luckless nation. Immorality followed in its train. France became the nauseous cesspool from which vomited forth all that was evil, all that was degrading, all that was defiling in styles, in amusements, in stage, in literature. In the wake of this immorality growing; out of this godlessness, Gaul succumbed to the ravages of the most unmentionable sociaal diseases. The penalty continued even to recent years. France lost the present war in thhe dens of Montmarte. God is using Hitler to 1 bring France to its knees in bitter penitence: over its infidelity and immorality.

What happened in Germany? History will tell you that Lutheran Germany was a thrifty, clean-living, moral, sober, home-loving nation. A change came with the introduction of rationalism, the school of thought which we here call moodernism. About 150 years ago, there arose in German universities a group of rationalizing, soo-called Christian philosophers, who denied the divine inspiration of the Bible, the virgin birth of the Lord Jesus Christ, the efficacy of the: atonement, the resurrection from the dead, the judgment, hell, and heaven. The foundatiions of faith and the fear of God were banished from the hearts of too many Germans. French indecency, hitherto stemmed by religious barriers, swept into this land also. Family and community religion began to die out. Cruelty, greed, bestiality, dreams of world conquest possessed the minds of the rulers. The swaggering, arrogant, sword-rattling Junker became the symbol of Germania. The loss of the last war rankled in the hearts of the military. Depression and the undoubted tyranny of some of the Versailles provisions added fuel. Hitler came along to become the match to set flame to this tinder-dry brushwood.

noxious fruit of rationalism, irreligion, selfishness, immorality. Given the fervent, forceful, faithful Lutheranism of Gustavus Adolphus and the other Protestant worthies, Germany could have stemmed and stifled the plague Nazism at the source. God is using Hitler to teach the rational outcome of rationalism, to bring the drifting German Christians, preachers, professors, lay folk, to a realization of their need of the Christ and the unadulterated, unexpurgated Bible.

What happened in Russai? The record is self-instructive. Under the czars, the Greek Orthodox Church priesthood was ignorant, iniquitous, ineffective. Instead of standing for and with the people, it joined hands with the tyrants to oppress, depress, and repress all of the commonality who, dissatisfied with their terrible poverty and illiteracy, were seeking a way out.

The Bolsheviki came along, essentially atheistic. They were of the people and, in theory at least, for the people. Overthrowing the government, they strove and are striving to banish all religion. * * *

The rationalism of Germany, the infidelity and immorality of France, crossed the English Channel, inundating the land of Latimer and Ridley, of Cromwell and Bunyan, of Spurgeon and Parker. England had forgotten the God of Kipling's "Recessional." Many of England's preachers, being more interested in the latest pronouncements from Rome (shades of the Puritans!) or from Russia, were in pinkish politics and communistic conclusions.

Formality supplanted fervor, while polite platitudes replaced passionate pleadings. Soous, maddening protem. Soul-winning is a lost art. Intercessory re conspicuous by their absence. Souls, so in, multiplied multitudes of them, are hastering down the broad way to hell. Many of ir preachers are modernistic, and most of mose who still claim the fundamentals of faith as their belief are lukewarm.

A million and more men, snatched out of the normal, productive, nation-building walks of life, trained to maim, to kill, to destroy, many of them to saturate some foreign soil with their hearts' blood, is the bitter answer. Pearl Harbor is the bloody answer. Nationwide blackouts are the bleak answer. God is using Hitler to remind America of the religion of the Pilgrim Fathers, the founders of this marvelous land of ours.

The Word of God is clear. The requirements of heaven are definite. "Come, and let us return unto the Lord," is the wide-open, the only available, way out.—King's Business and Religious Digest.
