the conversation turn on pleasant things that neighbors have done, the troubles and sorrows of acquaintances that may be shared prayerfully by the family, or the heavy burdens and responsibilities of community and government leaders which should cause families of concerned citizens to pray?

These are not idle questions. They bring us straight to the difference which exists between family tables that are under the rule of the devil and family tables that are truly the Lord's.

In those quarters of the earth where the professed church has lost her saltness, nothing remains but to be cast out and trodden under foot of men. Communism—which is essentially anti-God in its nature and methods—can flourish only where the true worship of God has fallen into decay. It is now sweeping China in such a way that even Russia stands aghast. Napoleon once said, "Let China sleep. When she awakens, the world will be sorry."

The uncanny advance in military science now renders certain that the next global war will be the last. One responsible statesman recently declared that there has In view of these events, none but the sin-hardened will fail to see His hand at work.
