ABOUT DR. WILSON

Dr. O. G. Wilson, Editor of The Wesleyan Methodist, for many years has been closely associated with youth work. For fourteen years he served as professor of Bible and Theology on the faculty of Miltonvale Wesleyan College, Miltonvale, Kansas. Hundreds of young men and women, now serving God in many professions and on foreign fields, gladly acknowledge their indebtedness to Dr. Wilson as teacher, friend, and counselor through college days.

In 1943 Dr. Wilson was first elected to a general office in the Wesleyan Methodist Church, serving as editor of the Sunday School literature for four years. At the succeeding General Conference Dr. Wilson was elected to his present position as Editor of The Wesleyan Methodist, which office he has served with great distinction and with much grace. For the past twelve years Dr. Wilson has been advisor to Wesleyan youth, lending his counsel and wisdom to many

of their significant movements of advance. For eight years he edited the Wesleyan Youth magazine. He is frequently quoted in religious periodicals.

Dr. Wilson speaks in language youth can understand because he understands and loves youth. His pulpit ministry and personal grace bear abundant evidence of his gifts, fitting him for a ministry to youth.

Dr. Wilson has had a rich background of academic training, and was honored for his outstanding scholarship and general church service by a Doctor of Divinity degree from Houghton College.
