The sacrifice which the Christian presents to God is to be holy. It was this, that it was put upon the altar. Yonder were a thousand lambs skipping and gamboling in their innocence, but no one of them was holier than another.

But when one of these was taken and consecrated to God, and touched the altar, it became a holy sacrifice and, in the very act of consecration, God considered and record it holy and acceptable. So now we come with our offering and put it upon the altar, our offering of body and soul to be a living sacrifice, and the offering of it makes it holy, for the altar sanctifieth the gift. If you wait, before you present yourself to God, until you are holy, you will never come to him.

Do not wait to make yourself right, but come to God and let Him make you right. I thank God that He has a place for one like me. I know that He looks upon me through the Son of His Love, and calls me to a holy sacrifice.
