Spirit, and pity those who try to pray without the help of the same Holy Ghost.

According to Romans 8:26, the Spirit helps us in prayer, and according to Ephesians 6:18 prayer is the life of the Christian. How good was David in the heavy armor of King Saul? The boy could not move an inch. Likewise, the Christian Soldier, well equipped with the armor of God needs the inner power and strength that comes only through "praying always . . . in the Spirit".

d. "Keep yourselves in the love of God", v. 21 How? By obedience to the known law of God, and an exercising of the above privileges and responsibilities. 2 Peter 1:10 " . . . IF ye do these things, ye shall never fall." If not what? Surely the logical conclusion is in complete agreement with the teaching of the Word and the nature of God. We need not fall, but we can fall, and we will fall, unless we avail ourselves of ALL that God has for us.

Note in closing, Paul's prayer for the Christians at Thessalonica, 1 Thess. 5:23 "And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly: and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Take care brethren, lest you argue against Jude and Paul and the Spirit of God on these questions of Perseverance and Holiness.
