When it was realized that a full time pastor and his family would be living in Digby, something had to be done about a parsonage. We were very fortunate in getting a house beside our church, and we have felt that the Lord definitely worked this out for us. The parsonage has been completely renovated inside and out, and we have a home that is comfortable which we appreciate very much.

By fall it was realized that if we expected to hold services in our church during the winter, a heating unit would have to be installed. A furnace room was built at the rear of the auditorium and a new unit was installed. This has certainly proven to be worth its cost during the past few months. Pews were taken from another church, refinished and placed in the auditorium. The walls and floor have been repainted, and now we have a place of worship that we can be proud of.

The congregation has grown steadily, and often we have seen people bowing at the place of prayer allowing the Lord to have His way in their lives. Recently we finished evangelistic meetings with Rev. Randolph Nicholson as our evangelist and in every service people were moved upon by the spirit of the Lord. The folk of the church and one outsider went to work inviting people into the meetings, and before they were concluded one man was responsible for bringing in around 115 new ones. Another lady brought in 75 or more. A good number of the young people worked hard too. At the close of the meeting we could look back and realize that some had been saved for the first time, others were reclaimed, and many had raised their hands signifying that they were concerned about their spiritual lives.

The people of the church have been wonderful to their pastor and family. In the fall they gave us a lovely donation of groceries and vegetables. Then at Christmas time we received many personal gifts along with a fine purse of money. Just before our special meetings they gave us another donation of groceries. After the meetings we received another purse of money. We thank the Lord for these good people, and the many ways in which they continually remember us.

Would you please continue to pray for us and the work here at Digby that it might abound more and more, in the things of the Lord and that many people might come to know Christ, whom to know aright is life eternal.
