THE YEAR AHEAD AT BETHANY

The staff and returning students look forward with anticipation to another year at Bethany. The "oldtimers"—happy about the outstanding year completed—have been infected with a Bethany enthusiasm, and contagion is taking place among the youth of our denomination. Several of the high school graduates of last June are planning to return (much to our delight) to take the one-year Christian Development Course and to continue further as God leads. Among these are Leslie Ingraham, Hanley Richardson, Raymond Mitchell, and Wayne Blinn. The grade ten pupils, almost without exception, are returning to take grade eleven. The second and third-year Bible students plan to return with only one exception. We expect to have our male quartet intact and most of our choir.

Personal conversations, correspondence, applications and reports indicate that there will be a healthy influx of new students in both the high school and Bible departments. Some former students plan to give up their work and return to Bethany to take Bible studies, among these is Harry Wilson. A former student who "found victory" at the recent Beulah Camp affirmed her intention to take the Christian Development Course. "I am tired of saying, 'I can't!" she commented, referring to her unpreparedness to serve Christ in the local church and community.

We know of high school graduates who are considering taking the one-year Christian Development Course before going on to teachers' College and further professional training and of others who are thinking of taking a year off from teaching to enroll in the Christian Development Course. These developments indicate two heartening facts:

(1) There is an increasing concern on the part of our youth to be strong and effective Christians in their particular walks of life (2) They are coming to appreciate the Christian Development Course as a means to that end.
