STEPS TO A REVIVAL

Thomas Cook of England, a flaming Methodist evangelist of the old days, believed that preaching of sanctification was the first condition of revival. "Long ago," he said, "I learned the lesson that if we would convert sinners we must revive saints. This is not only needful because the converts in a period of revival are almost certain to conform to the type of the average professor, but because the harboring of unkind feelings, the want of charity and forbearance, ill-will, the indulgence of prejudices or animosities, prevent the outpouring of God's Spirit, without which all our efforts are in vain. The preaching of the doctrine of entire sanctification prepares the way of the Lord by welding his people together in unity and love as no other truth does. Indeed, it is as Wesley said, "Wherever a work of sanctification breaks out, the work of God prospers.'"
