YOUTH RALLY NOTES

(1) ACCOMMODATIONS

Accommodations will be provided for all young people who register. No accommodations will be provided until after the Friday night service. No meals will be served on Friday.

Registrations and requests for accommodations are to be on the same form this year. Please do not write to Marysville for accommodations.

(2) BANQUET AT U.N.B.

A chicken dinner banquet will be held at U.N.B. on Saturday at 3:30 P.M. with Rev. Maurice Boillat of Moncton, N. B., as the speaker. The cost of the banquet is only \$2.00 per person and is included in the registration fee. Those living in the Fredericton area, not required to register, must purchase their tickets in advance.

(3) YOUTH LEADERS BREAKFAST

A special feature of this year's rally is a Youth Leader's Breakfast at the Lord Beaverbrook Hotel on Saturday at 8:30 A.M. The cost is \$1.25 per person. Youth presidents, pastors (if possible) and all interested young people should attend this breakfast. It is necessary to indicate on the registration form whether or not you plan to attend.

(4) ATTENDANCE BANNER

The Attendance Banner which has been presented in the past to the society having the most members present, will not be presented this year at the rally.

(5) ATTENDANCE AT THE SERVICES

All young people registered for the rally must attend every service of the rally.

(6) PARENTS WITH CHILDREN

Parents who will be bringing children under 13 years of age should provide their own accommodations.

(7) PRAYER

MAN'S WORK IN SANCTIFICATION

The term sanctification has two meanings. First, it means to consecrate, to set apart for a special purpose. Second, it means to purify, to cleanse, to make clean.

Consecration is man's work; sanctification is God's work. God said to His ancient people, "sanctify yourselves, and be ye holy". In the very next verse He says "I am the Lord which sanctifies you" (Ex. 20:7-8).
