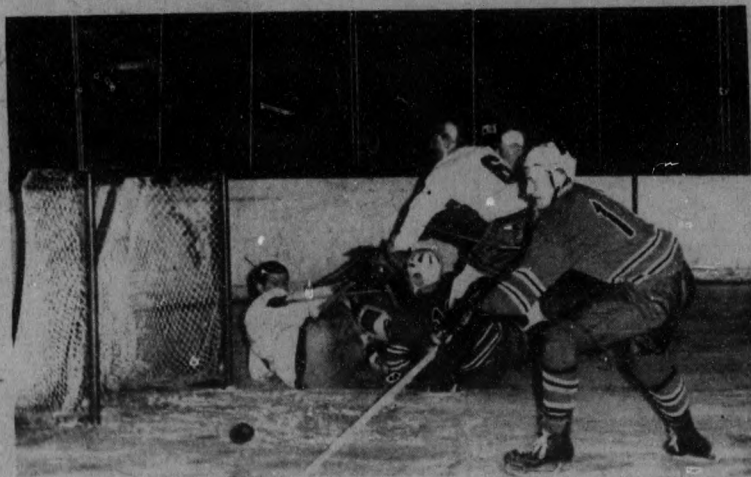
DEVILS PLACE THREE MEN ON ALL-CANADIAN TEAM

The University of New Brunswick Red Devils paced by all-stars Jack Drover, Eddie Grant and Darryl LeBlanc outdistanced the University of Montreal Carabins in a high scoring contest 8-6 to capture the consolation title after losing to the University of Alberta Golden Bears 5-3 in the opening game Friday night.

Following the tournament, at the banquet, which was addressed by Judy LaMarsh, the Minister for Health and Welfare, the all-star selections were announced. UNB placed three players on the first team. Jack Drover won a spot on the first defence along with Dick Wintermute of the University of Alberta. Eddie Grant was chosen as the all-star centre and Darrell LeBlanc received the vote at one wing. The other forward to place on the team was Gilles LeFort of the University of Montreal. The all-star goalie was Dale

DEVILS OUTPACE CARABINS IN HIGH-SCORING TILT

The Devils met the University of Montreal Carabins in the consolation match after the Carabins dropped to Sir George Williams University 5-1 the previous evening. The Devils outskated, outmuscled and outscored the Carabins to come out on top 8-6. The Devils fell behind in the first period but pulled ahead in the second and never looked back.

The Devils opened the scoring in the first period when Garnet Stairs took Pooch Clark's pass and drove the puck past Viau, the Montreal Goalie. The Carabins caught up when LeFort beat Wrigley in a goalmouth scramble. The Devils again took the lead when Eddie Grant scored a picturesque goal on a pass from Drover. In the latter minutes of the period the Carabins tied the score and took the lead on goals by LeFort and Delorme. The teams went to the dressing rooms at the end of the period with the Carabins holding a shortlived lead 3-2.

The Devils jumped upon the Montreal team in the second minute of play of the second period with a goal by Ken Marchant.
