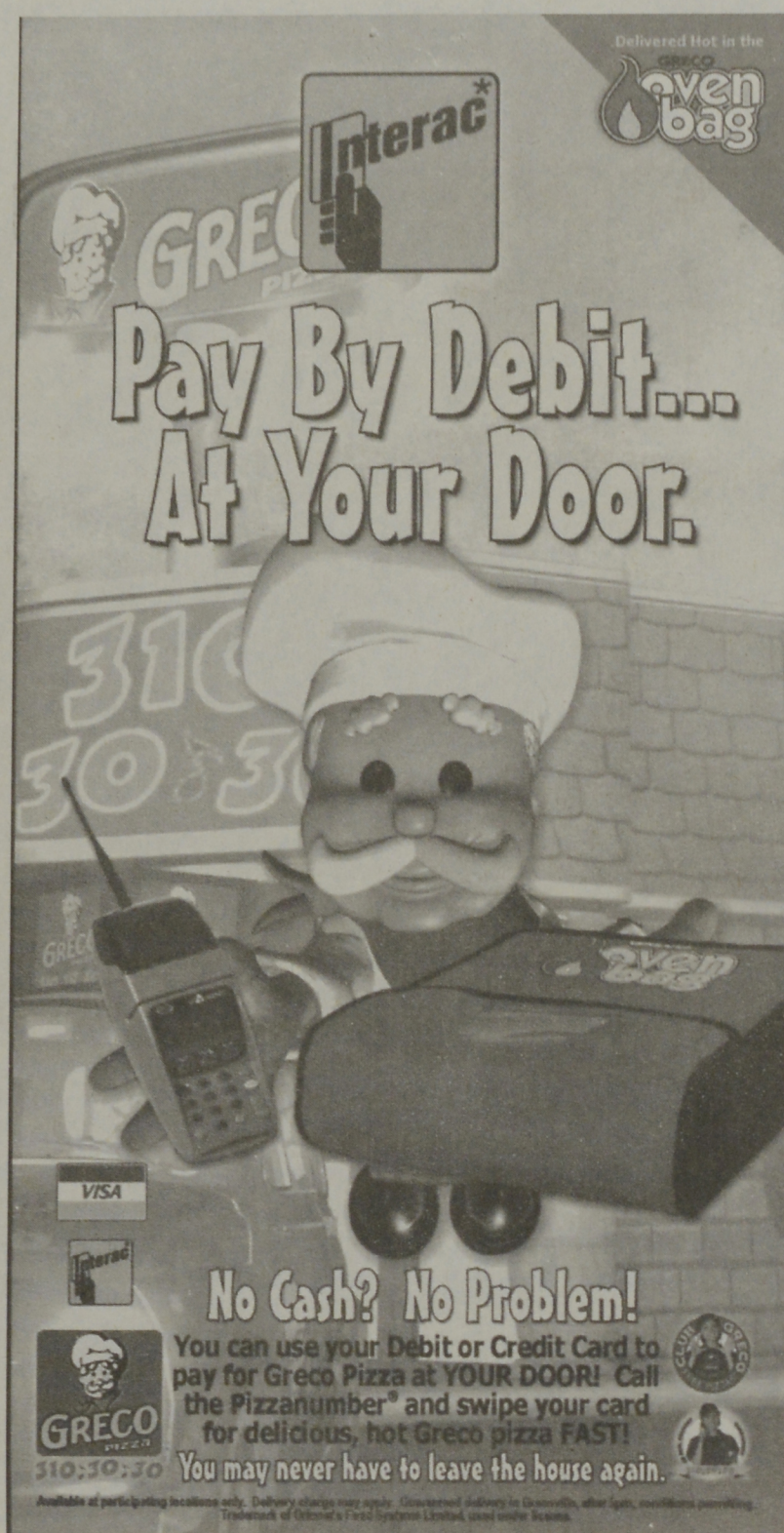


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Knowlton Nash announces Dalton Camp scholarships

**Former CBC National
broadcaster speaks at STU**

We need to find ways to improve the quality of the news...to energize brain cells and not just zap eyeballs, said Knowlton Nash at the launch of the Dalton Camp Award late last month. The respected author and former host of CBC's The National announced the award at STU, which encourages a new generation of Canadians to link democratic values and journalistic quality.

The award, sponsored by the Friends of Canadian Broadcasting, will honour the memory of the late Dalton Camp,

one of Canada's most revered journalists and political figures.

The Dalton Camp Award will be available to up to three Canadians each year, and will consist of a \$5000 prize for a winning essay on how the media influences Canadian democracy.

Citing Camp's faith in the younger generation of journalists, Nash said the intention is to get young people involved in improving the quality of journalism.

"We need to make the important interesting, and not make the merely interesting seem important," Nash told a crowd of journalists and journalism students at St. Thomas University.

"Dalton was always young," added Nash, "and I think he always looked to the new generation for inspiration."

CBC host Michael Camp said his father knew the value of getting a little recognition, and even the value of getting a little money.

"He would be proud if he knew one of these awards would lead to a young person getting a brilliant foundation in journalism," said Camp.

The deadline for entries is March 31, 2003, and the announcement of the winner(s) will be held during the 2003 Banff Television Festival in June.

The Dalton Camp Award follows on the heels of St. Thomas University's 1.5 million Dalton K. Camp Endowment, launched early last year.

The endowment will serve to fund a Journalist in Residence, a lecture series, scholarships, bursaries, and internships for the university's Bachelor of Arts in Journalism program.

Union. The nominee for this position must run for the board of governor's student representative.

Next in line, the VP executive is responsible for federal and provincial lobby initiatives and oversees media relations. As well the VP executive will assist the president and is responsible for the vice presidents and the staff.

Money matters are taken care of by the VP finance, the Chief Financial Officer. They are the Vice-chair of Orientation. In this position the nominee will be responsible for all of the clubs and societies involved in the union.

The VP University affairs must be a liaison with Fredericton Senate and must run for the student seat in Senate. This person is responsible for Saferide, Smartpace, the Advocacy center and the general elections. The VP University affairs will act on behalf of the union to ensure that all students receive fair treatment within the university.

Responsibility for student services lies in the hands of the VP student services. They are responsible for the PaperTrail, the information center, the Beaverbook, yearbook, Health Plan and the off-campus housing website.

All of these positions run on a 15-hour

minimum workweek during the academic year and are full-time during the summer, with the exception of president. The president is limited to taking only two courses per term, as it is a full time position, running from May to May.

Voting for these positions will be held from March 12 to March 22 and will be ratified by council on April first. The Student Union is hoping to rid campus

of student apathy for a better voter turn out this year. Last year only 20 percent of students voted.

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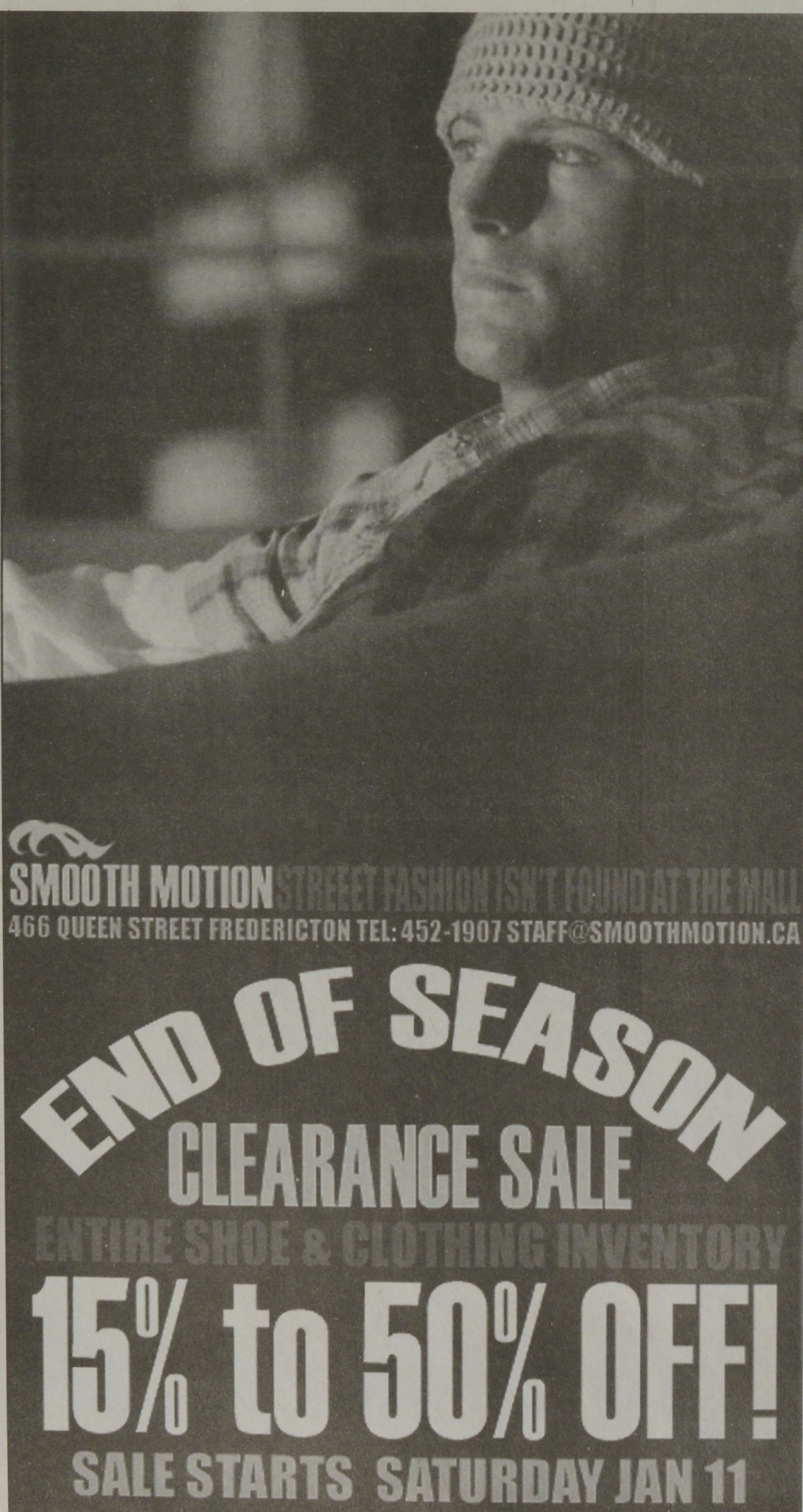

Service Workers: including openings for kitchen, laundry, housekeeping, secretaries, maintenance & grounds, and kitchen supervisor.

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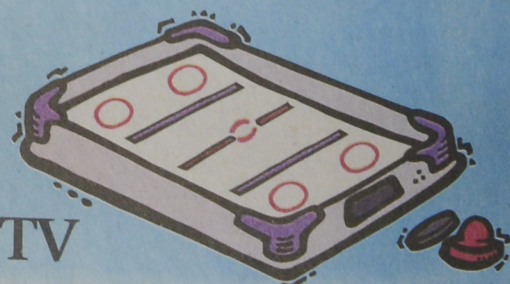
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
