## Clubs & Societies News

Ok folks, as the administrative structure for how we are going to be dealing with Special Projects funding requests takes shape, I just wanted to take a moment to fill you in on some of the larger details. The full details will be available at the annual Clubs and Societies meeting to be held Thursday October 21st, with the location to be announced once I figure it out. For now I will give you a brief run-down on the system so far

Basically what will happen is that when your group decides they want to hold an event you will be required to fill out some paperwork (The Special Projects Request Package). The exact details of what you will be required to include in this paperwork are still being worked out, but will undoubtedly be somewhat similar to the requirements in place from previous years. You will need to include items such as a budget for the event detailing revenues and expenses, a write-up on why this is an event that will benefit the student body as whole, and some other details.

Based on the package you submit and discussions

with representatives of your group your request will be evaluated by the Special Projects Committee. This committee has the authority to grant requests up to the amount of \$500.00, with requests over that amount requiring a majority vote of the Union Council to be approved. We will also be implementing a firm series of deadlines so that groups will have a precise date for when the will have a response to their request.

Again the process for moving the request package from Club or Society to Council is still being worked on. We continue to hold discussions with our Council members on how to best maintain communication between the various groups on campus and the Union, and until these issues are worked out I can't really tell you any more details of the application process than that.

If any C&S executive members would like to speak in a little more detail about the process I can typically be found in my office (room 126 in the SUB) pretty much any time on Tuesdays and Thursdays so feel free to stop by and get the full run down.
