Sodexho is the only food provider on the UNB campus (besides the Cellar Pub & Grill) and does residential, commercial and conference serving. Every residence student has to buy a meal card from Sodexho, and has to eat their food at one of the four dining locations around campus at least twice a day. Sodexho also runs all of the food outlets in the

SUB. Starting to notice a trend? Sodexho has a virtual monopoly over the food provided at UNB. So what does this mean to you, the student? It means that if you're eating at UNB, you're eating Sodexho.

Recently, the UNB Student Union has been receiving complaints about the food quality, prices and options of Sodexho. So, we are asking you, what do you think about Sodexho? Do you

find they serve healthy, fresh food? Do you find there are enough options for vegetarians or international students? Do you think you pay too much for milk in the SUB cafeteria? We need your input.

Recently, Sodexho did a survey of its students. A piece of paper was handed out during a single meal to students as they swiped their card. However, there was little, if any, promotion of it to students. Students had no idea it was happening, had little time to prepare their responses and couldn't fill it out if they missed that one meal. Your Student Union thinks there should be something more. Your Student Union wants to hear your thoughts about Sodexho and its food, so we're doing our own survey.

I'm sure you've seen, by now, announcements of this week's by-election, and campaign materials from the 17 candidates running. Whether or not you belong to a faculty that is electing representative to Student Union Council, you will all be able to vote for one of the three candidates offering for Senator. Now, all that remains is for you to log in to <http://www.unb.ca/eservices>, and click on the "Voting" tab, and make your choice.

I've been wondering all month how many of you will actually do so. Student Union elections, even on the most politically engaged campuses, do not typically attract that many voters. When we're talking by-elections, the numbers are even smaller. Based on anecdotal evidence, I would say that average turnout for a Student Union election in Canada is about 10%, and probably half that for a by-election. For some reason, not so for UNB.

Last General Election, we had an unprecedented level of turnout, a little over 32%. Some of reasons I've heard include the ease of voting presented by our online system, people having a particular interest in the U-PASS referendum, and a hotly contested presidential race, to name a few. We are the envy of other Maritime institutions, who are looking at us to see what we are doing right. Some might even say these factors made turnout "artificially" high, but I don't buy it. Turnout is turnout, people were obviously inspired to take notice, to take the time and make a choice. I hope we can replicate last year's results, and improve on them.

This week, the posters are down, but the candidates will be out, shaking hands and giving you a great reason to take the momentum from last year, and break record another record for being an engaged, critical and thoughtful body of citizens.

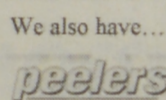
