

SPANISH TO BUILD THEIR DREADNAUGHTS

Paris, Dec. 10-The Spanish naval program has just been decided upon according to a special despatch from Madrid. It will comprise three dreadnoughts of 21,000 tons each, two of the latest type of destrovers, nine torpedo boats and three submarines.

All the vessels are to be constructed in Spanish shipbuilding yards. The work is to be begun as soon as the battleship Alfonso XIII has been launched at Ferrol.

The new dreadnought Espala which was launched early this year will be delivered in April next.


