HOUSE OF COMMONS ADJOURNS TONIGHT

Ottawa, Dec. 18—The commons will rise tonight for the Christmas recess and many of the members left for home today, so that Hon. Geo. E. Foster's speech on the naval bill this afternoon will not be heard by the full house he usually commands. While little has been accomplished by Parliament so far the pre-Christmas sitting has been instrumental in getting preliminaries cleared away and when the house resumes on January 14th, good progress can be made with the country's legislation.

Hon. Frank Cochrane has introduced two bills relating to the G.T.P. and N.T.R. and giving the Governor-in-Council authority to grant any necessary time extensions for the completion of the roads.

ARCHBISHOP CASEY FORMALLY INDUCTED

(Vancouver World, Dec. 9.)

Archbishop Casey, the new head of the Vancouver diocese of the Catholic church, was formally installed in the office on Sunday afternoon with impressive ceremony in the Church of the Holy Rosary. He was accompanied by Most Rev. Archbishop McNeil, Archbishop-elect of Toronto; Rt. Rev. Bishop McDonald and Very Rev. Father Nocolava, V.G., of Vancouver Island; Very Rev. Father Welch, Provincial of the Oblate Order; Rev. Father McDonnell, O.S.B., Fort Augustus, Scotland; Rev. Fathers Bonner, McKinnon, McNeil and LeChesne, O.M.I., as he entered the sacristy.

A procession of priests passed from the sanctuary to the front of the church, where the archbishop-elect formally took possession. The proceedings were attended by hundreds of persons, and the big church was crammed with those who wished to see the new head inducted.

After bestowing his blessing upon both priests and people, Archbishop Casey took his seat upon the draped throne and Father Connolly read the papal bull authorizing the transition from St. John to Vancouver.

After the reading of the papal bull, an address of welcome from the clergy was read by the Rev. Father Welch, its purport being an assurance of the loyalty of the priests and the promise of co-operation with the new archbishop in the work he had undertaken.

It said in part:

"We feel that you will find in this great and comparatively undeveloped country a field large enough to enable you to exercise in a marked degree those great qualities of mind and heart that have made your ministrations in your last field of labor so successful, as is evidenced by the magnificent demonstration you received when bidding farewell to your flock and other denominations on your departure from among them."

Mr. J. F. Barry also read an address of welcome on behalf of the laity.

His Grace was visibly affected as he ascended the pulpit to make his reply. He expatiated on the text: "He that leaveth father or mother, sister or brother, for my sake, shall receive in return one hundredfold and life everlasting."

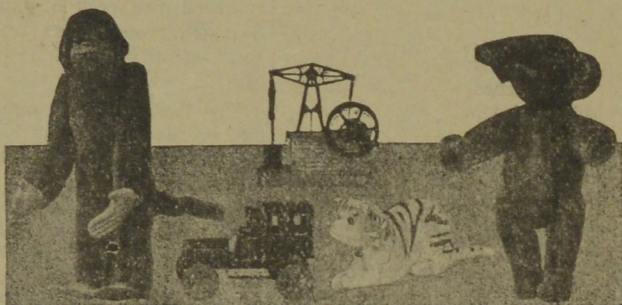
