
MUSHROOM CONSOMME

Have ready five cups of stro broth, made of best, veal or chicken, or both and flavored with the usual Soup vegetables free from all fat. Add half a cup of dried mushrooms soaked for an hour or more in cold wgter and pounded smooth, the slightly beaten whites of two eggs and the crushed shalls of the same, and mix all together thoroughly. Set the soup over a slow fire, and stir constantly while heating the whole to a boiling point; let simmer ten minutes then draw to a cooler place to settle, skim and strain through a naplen wrung out of boiling water Season as needed with salt and pep per and serve at once.
