

Ottawa, Ont., Aug. 14-A forma pplication has been made to the ecretary of state by the directors of the C. P. R. for an increase in its capital stock. For some time there have been rumors in the stock mar ket that the C. P. R. was contem plating an increase in its stock and the application proves that the specu-ation was justified. It could not be earned how much increase is asked or but the rumor goes that the proosal is for an increase of capitaliza-ion from two hundred to three hun ired million. The reasons assigne are the requirements for improve ments and extensions of the roa particularly in the west. For the in crease in stock legislation is no necessary as it can be provided for by ordinary letters patent issued by the department of state with the anction of the government.

The announcement is made that Col. Sam Hughes will sail next week for Europe. For the good of Canada it is hoped that Premier Borden will see to it that he is securely muzzled before he is turned loose on the other side.
