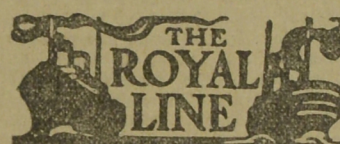

Ottawa, Jan. 17.—It now looks as though there would be a contest in South Renfrew with Hon. George P. Graham on one side and Dr. Mulloney on the other. A convention of the Conservatives will be held in the town of Renfrew on Friday to decide whether a candidate shall be put up or if faith will be kept with the Liberals, who allowed Mr. McGarry to go to the Ontario House unopposed on condition that there would be no opposition to Mr. Graham.

The indications are that the convention will repudiate the agreement and nominate a candidate.

Dr. Mulloney wants the nomination and says that in this there is no bad faith on his part, as he declined to be a party to the agreement.

NOTORIOUS CRIMINAL CAUGHT AT GLASGOW

Glasgow, Jan. 18.—A man who was arrested here last night, on a charge of loitering in a hotel with intent to steal, claims he is Eddie Guerin, the so-called American criminal although an English Judge once decided that he was a British subject. The man has not yet been identified.

Eddie Guerin's name was known all over the world through his sensational escape from the French penal colony at Devil's Island, and where he was serving a life sentence.

Guerin, who is catalogued in Inspector Bryne's book as a notorious western criminal, got his life sentence on Devil's Island, for robbing the American Express Company in Paris of \$30,000 and for a previous robbery of \$50,000 from the Bank of Lyons.

SWIFT JUSTICE FOR BOMB THROWER

Pekin, Jan. 18.—The three men who were arrested after they had thrown the bomb at the carriage of the Premier Yuan Shi Kai, were executed this morning when they were strangled by the public executioner.

Premier Yuan Shi Kai attended today the memorial rites for the captain of his escort, who were killed yesterday from the splinter of the bomb.

The Premier has been granted three days leave ostensibly on account of indisposition arising from the excitement caused by the attempt on his life. It is thought however that he does not desire to attend the conference of the Empress Dowager and the Prince of the Imperial Clan on the question of the abdication at the Imperial Palace tomorrow.

ATTEMPT TO DESTROY FAMOUS BAPTISTRY

Pisa, Italy, Jan. 18.—A determined attempt was made here yesterday to blow up the famous Baptistery which was begun in 1153 and not completed until 1278. The building which is entirely of marble is opposite the famous Cathedral and adjacent to the leaning tower. Two watchmen in making their rounds noticed some smoke coming from underneath the door of the Baptistery. An investigation followed, and a burning fuse was discovered attached to a contrivance on the door panels. The inside of this contrivance as subsequent investigation showed, was filled with gunpowder and the outside had been soaked in kerosene. The watchmen acted quickly and turned on a stream of water which extinguished the burning fuse. This averted not only the probable destruction of the Baptistery but disaster to the marble Cathedral and the Leaning Tower.

IN MEMORY OF GENERAL LEE

Atlanta, Ga., Jan. 19.—The 185th anniversary of the birth of General Robert E. Lee was celebrated throughout the south today. In practically all of the Southern States the day is observed as a legal holiday. Banks and public offices were closed, and in most places the schools were opened only in the forenoon to allow commemorative exercises to be held.
