## JOY-RIDING CASE IN TRURO COURT

(Moncton Transcript.)

Mayor Robinson, Ald. Price, Ald. S. O. Humphrey and City Engineer Edington visited Truro in May last and were given a joy-ride about the city with the result that the drivers and owners of the automobiles were brought into court and fined \$5. They appealed the case, which is now being conducted at Truro. A Truro despatch says:

The famous joy-riding case which was tried before Stipendiary Crowe, in May last and the judgment given against the joy-riders, was revived yesterday on an appeal and the case is now being tried before Judge Chipman. The amount involved is a fine of \$5 which was imposed upon the drivers of the automobiles for exceeding the speed limit.

It will be remembered that the mayor of Moncton and several Moncton aldermen were invited for an auto drive by Mayor Stuart and several civic officials were in the party, which was driven in the machines of C. B. McMullen, Arthur Stevens and Alonso McCullum.

Two days previous to this event a lad of ten years, Willie Ferguson, had been killed on Prince street and the police were warned to keep a sharp lookout for offenders and prosecute them. It came as a big sensation that Mayor Stuart was one of the party against whom the first complaint was lodged with conviction following. The case against McMullen occupied all yesterday and is not finished. The case against Stevens will then be proceeded with.

St. Louis, Mo., Nov. 12--The Mississippi River Commission met for its annual fall session on board the steamer Mississippi here today. The meeting will be followed by an inspection trip down the river to New Orleans. Public hearings on matters connected with the improvement of the river will be given at many points along the route.

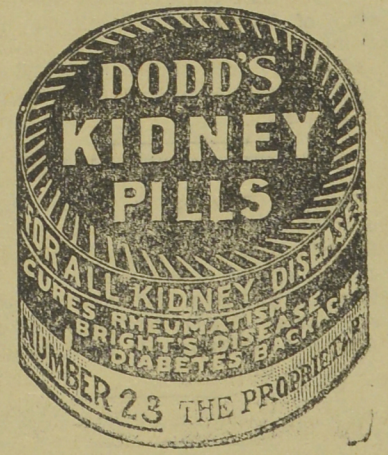
