# AROUND MONASTIR

Belgrade, Nov. 18-A fierce fight for the possession of Turkish fortress at Monastir continues between the Servian and Greeks on one side and the Turkish garrison on the other. defenders of city knowing that their line of communication with Ochrida on which they would naturally retreat in case of defeat has been cut are fighting desperately. The losses of the Servians has been heavy. During the first days battle, 250 of them were killed and wounded.
