## FARMER KILLED BY LIGHTNING

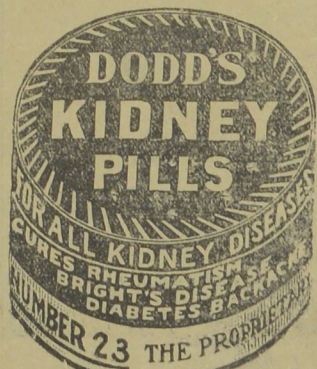
Guelph, July 16—Another terrible thunderstorm visited Guelph and vicinity today. In many places the standing crops were completely leveled and much property has been destroyed by wind and rain. North and east of Guelph the storm was the worst, and it is reported here that several barns were struck by lightning and destroyed.

It was especially severe in the vicinity of Erin, where much damage was done. During the storm in that section, which was a fierce one while it lasted, John W. Bettenson, a farmer living on Lot 3, Con. 7, Peel, was struck by lightning and instantly killed. It appears that Mr. Bettenson noticed the storm approaching and proceeded hastily to the field where his youngest son, Carl, was at work with the discs. While he was on his way the storm broke and in one of the heavy flashes of lightning Mr. Bettenson was struck and instantly killed. He was a widower and leaves a family of five or six children.

## WILL FIGHT U.S. BEEF TRUST

Melbourne, Aus., July 18—Answering the question in the House of Representatives yesterday, with reference to the report that the American Beef Combine was establishing a big meat packing works in Australia, Premier Fisher said: "The government will spare no efforts and no expense and will use all the means in its power to protect Australia from the rapacity which has characterized the operations of the American Beef Trust in other countries."
