

OF INTEREST TO WOMEN

COLORED CLOTHES.

Colored clothes in general should be washed in lukewarm water and neutral soap solution, and the fabric squeezed rather than rubbed, according to the bulletin. Unless the color is fast, no colored clothes should be soaked for any length of time, nor should they be boiled or exposed to too high a temperature in washing, rinsing, starching or ironing. If the color seems very delicate, very cool water is advisable, and soap bark, bran or cooked starch water should be used instead of soap.

With a color likely to fade or run rapid washing is safest the material should be wrung as dry as possible and rolled in a cloth to absorb extra moisture; an even safer way is to shake the garment dry. For dark colors it is well to tint the starch; for example tea may be used for blacks, browns and greens, and bluing for blues, and the specially prepared "mourning" starch for blacks.

PORK SPICE CAKE.

This recipe is over three hundred years old. It makes a delicious old-time goody. Place in a mixing bowl:

Four ounces of fresh pork, sausage meat,

Four ounces of lard,
One and one-half cups of brown sugar,

Cream and add

Three and one-half cups of flour
One-half cup of cocoa,

Two teaspoons of cinnamon,
One teaspoon of nutmeg,

One-half teaspoon of allspice,
Three level tablespoons of baking powder

One cup of black coffee,
One-half cup of molasses,

One cup of seeded raisins.

Beat hard to mix, and then bake in an oblong baking pan in a slow oven for fifty-five minutes.

INDIAN MEAL DUMPLING.

Lemon Sauce.

Place in a saucepan:

One and one-half cups of water,
One-half cup of syrup.

Two-thirds cup of brown sugar,
Six tablespoons of good shortening

One teaspoon of salt.
Begin to boil and add:

One cup of cornmeal.

Cook until thick, like mush, and then turn into a bowl and cool, and then add the

Grated ring of one lemon.
One-half package of seeded raisins.

One-half pound of prunes, stones removed,

One teaspoon of nutmeg.
Mix thoroughly, and then turn into well-greased and floured pudding bag and boil for one hour. Serve with lemon sauce.

LEMON SAUCE.

Grated rind of one lemon,
Strained juice of two lemons.

Two-thirds cup of sugar,
One cup of water,

Six tablespoons of cornstarch.

Stir to dissolve the sugar and starch, and then bring to a boil and cook slowly for five minutes. Remove from the fire and add the yolk of one egg. Beat to blend, and then fold in the stiffly beaten white of egg and cool. Serve.

OLD-FASHIONED BROWN BETTY.

Grease a pudding dish, and then dust liberally with breadcrumbs. Now place a layer of finely chopped apples and season each layer with brown sugar and cinnamon and a dash of cloves, ginger and three tablespoons of candied citron, three tablespoons of jam or jelly.

Place an inch layer of fine breadcrumbs between each two-inch layer of apples, and have the bread-crumbs on top. Now melt three tablespoons of butter in one-half cup of water and pour it over the betty. Bake in a slow oven for thirty-five minutes and then serve with butterscotch sauce.



LONDON BANKER IS AN OPTIMIST

Economic conditions in Great Britain should correct themselves within about three months, according to E. C. Grenfell, head of the London house of Morgan, Grenfell & Co., who is visiting New York before setting out on a five week cruise among the West Indies.

"Though there are between one million and one million and a half men out of employment in England today, wages have not yet receded to anywhere near the scale which obtained in pre-war times," said Mr. Grenfell, "and I fear that unemployment will reach a much higher figure before the

business trend is upward. To take one industry as an example, the cost of shipbuilding today is about four times what it was a few years ago and many of the larger ship-owning concerns are retrenching in their policies, either cancelling or postponing their orders. This condition is general, as it has been in the United States, and has not yet reached its lowest point. When this is attained, however, the recovery should be as rapid as the turn which affairs have taken on this side with the past few weeks. I believe such a recovery should assert itself within ninety days."

"Do you believe that the competition of American shipping has been seriously felt by British interests since the war?" Mr. Grenfell was asked.

"Only to a certain extent. There is

room and need for both to help carry on the commerce of the world and, although the merchant marine of the United States is today the strongest competitive factor with which we have to deal, there has been no dearth of business for British bottoms because of it."

"Do you believe the centre of world finance has definitely shifted from England to the United States?"

"Only temporarily," he replied. "England's prestige has been due to the cosmopolitan viewpoint of her investing class and their readiness to place their funds in industries outside of the British dominions. Unless and until Americans reach that same viewpoint the United States will be unable to hold her own as a world financial centre. Here, as in shipping, there is room for both. Until England returns to a gold standard, however, the United States will have opportunity to extend her advantage."

Following the West Indian cruise Mr. Grenfell will return to the United States for a brief stay.
