SIR LOMER DEFINES HIS POSITION

(Moncton Transcript.)

Government organs and supporters having done their best to make trouble in the ranks of the Liberals by representing that the entrance of Sir Lomer Gouin into the field is part of a manoeuvre to supplant Mackenzie King in the leadership or if not that an attempt to deliver a portion of the Liberal Party over to a new alliance with Conservative interests—it is well that Sir Lomer's position, as set forth by him at the convention at which he was nominated, should be stated. Among other things, Sir Lomer said:

"It is simply as a soldier in the great Liberal army, as a candidate in Laurier-Outremont, that I will do my part in this election, supporting the party and doing the duties that should be accomplished in the next parliament at Ottawa. Without wishing to pose as a prophet, I believe that I have enough experience to say that on the 6th of December there will be a change in the Government of this country. The 6th of December Hon. William Lyon Mackenzie King, my chief, the Chief of the Liberal Party and his brave lieutenants, who before 1911, and after, led the fights of the Liberal Party and upheld the Liberal cause, will direct me, and will bring our country back to the golden years of Laurier. I present myself in Laurier-Outremont simply as a Liberal, partisan of the principles and aspirations and of the ideals of the Liberal Party, for which purpose you have chosen me, and for which purpose you will elect me."

This should effectually set at rest all reports as to where Sir Lomer stands. There is good reason to think that he was persuaded to enter the contest at the solicitation of leading men of both old political parties, and that some of the Conservatives who urged him to do so acted on the ground that the gravity of the situation confronting the country demanded that a man of Sir Lomer's experience should be sent to Parliament, where his experience would be especially valuable in the immediate future. But it will be observed that he goes as a Liberal committed to Liberal principles and as a lieutenant under the acknowledged leadership of Mackenzie King.

INDICTED FOR LARCENY

New York, Nov. 4.—Herbert T. Andrews, the Wall St. Broker, who attracted Nationwide attention last March when it was learned he was living with two wives in an apartment in Jersey City, was indicted for grand larceny today.

He furnished \$5000 bail, pending trial. The indictment charged he sold \$100 shares of stock which had been placed with him as collateral, not to be sold or transferred.

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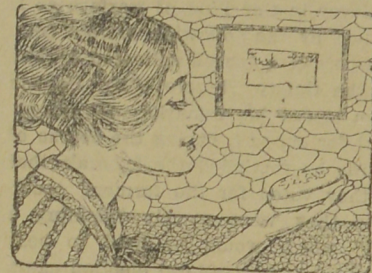
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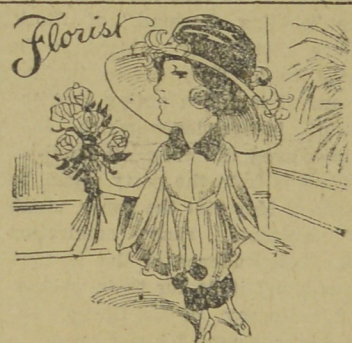
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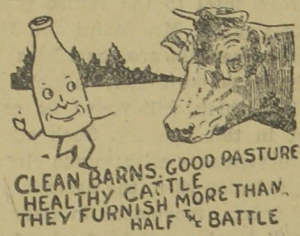
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
