DALHOUSIE ATTITUDE TOWARD INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS NOT FAIR TO OTHER COLLEGES

Rod MacDonald has been elected captain of the Dalhousie University hockey team for the present season and the Boston Arena has signified a willingness to have the Yellow and Black team play at Boston. The Dal team will show a considerable difference from last winter however, as the remarkably good aggregation of players gathered to represent the Halifax College in 1921 will not be available this season.

Halifax papers report Dalhousie as considering the advisability of withdrawal from intercollegiate sport because of "dissatisfaction with the treatment" received from other colleges in the matter of restrictions as to players eligible. The fact that games played in Antigonish and Windsor do not pay expenses for Dal also is cited as an objection. The treatment given Dalhousie is no different from that given any other of the six colleges in the matter of eligibility. The requirements in short are bona fide registration and attendance at classes in a specified number of subjects, a four-year limit on college athletics for any one man and absence of a degree. The rules are generally recognized wherever intercollegiate athletics are followed. In the United States the larger institutions make them more drastic by barring freshmen. The object of the rules is obvious. It is to put competition on a basis as equitable as possible and to do away with the college "ringer" who has been noticeable in college athletics in days gone by. Dal has a registration twice that of the college nearest in size and three times that of the majority. It is not obvious where the injustice comes in.
