Late in the day the department received a cablegram from Admiral Fletcher announcing that "Daniel Madero and five companions were received this morning on board the Louisiana as refugees."

It was said at the navy department that no special instructions had been given in regard to the treatment of the refugees, though the admiral had been told to confer with John Lind, who last evening had been authorized by President Wilson himself to extend protection to the Maderos.

PRESS SCORES WILSON.

Mexico City, Nov. 21.—Commenting on the situation in an editorial article today, El Pais says:

"Does President Wilson not know or does he not care to know that in history and before the civilized world he will be obliged to answer the charges which humanity will make against Francisco Villa."

The article then recapitulates the crimes of murder and pillage attributed to Francisco Villa, the rebel leader, at Torreon and Juarez, alleging that if the revolution triumphs Villa will become vice-president, minister of war, or some other functionary by virtue of the valuable services he has rendered to Carranza, the Constitutionalist leader. It continues:

"This President Wilson should know and does know for a certainty, yet, wishing to justify his unwarranted and absurd meddling in our affairs, he chooses to protect Francisco Villa, the better to impose his will and caprice upon Mexico even though such a course be the direct cause of crimes without number, such as have been committed at Torreon, Juarez and many other towns."

KNABE MURDER

Webster, so it is stated, found that Dr. Knabe, who was a lecturer on pathology in the Indiana Veterinary College, of which Dr. Craig has been dean for a number of years, had been an intimate friend of Dr. Craig, who is a widower, a little more than forty years of age. Dr. Knabe was a frequent visitor at Dr. Craig's home and, as Webster is said to have ascertained, was anxious to become the wife of Craig. The latter, who has several children from his first marriage, is said to have been opposed to this plan and it is believed that Dr. Knabe visited the house of Dr. Craig under some pretext on the evening before the murder, to persuade Dr. Craig to marry her.

The exact nature of the evidence collected by Detective Webster has never been divulged but it was evidently sufficiently convincing to induce the grand jury to find an indictment against Dr. Craig and Alonzo M. Ragsdale. The arrest of the two men, who were both socially quite prominent, caused a tremendous sensation in Indianapolis at the time. Both men were arraigned for a preliminary hearing and released under heavy bail. It is understood that since the finding of the indictment the state has found some additional evidence of important bearing upon the case and it is believed that the trial will bring some extremely startling and sensational disclosures.

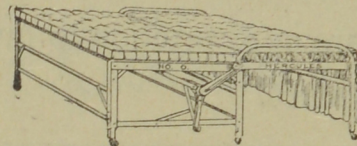
