

noon and the crowd, double that of Then the court spoke, first in English and then in French:

"I must say I was shocked this morning," he said, "to be a witness of a most disgraceful scene in this court, one which would give a very poor idea of the dignity with which the sittings of our courts are held, and which I trust and hope will be aken as the exception, not the rule. I have been long at the bar and I have been some time on the bench, but I must declare that I have never witnessed such a scene and that i any attempt is made to repeat the conduct of this morning, I will have the guilty parties put in the jail."

In the face of such solemn warning not a sound escaped the crowd when the court sustained Thaws counsel in the contention that they were thin their rights in withdrawing writ of hor pas corpus. The court held in brief that a man may discontinue any proceedings he has undertaken in his own behalf, provided that there is no specific law forbid-

'I therefore grant the application" he concluded, "and order him (Thaw) on the benefit I have since derived. recommitted to jail to be dealt with according to law on the charge that stands against him."

MAY APPLY FOR BAIL

Sherbrooke, Que., Aug. 27 .- At .30 o'clock this afternoon Justice Hohensky rendered judgment, grantg a discontinuance of the Habeas Corpus proceedings and ordered Thaw returned to the Sherbrooke

This places the case exactly where t stood before the writ of Habeas Corpus was taken out. Thaw is in Sherbrooke jail on a commitment made at Coaticook. The lawyers for the defence claim he can stay as long as it pleases him as the comnitment is for an indefinite period It is impossible to say what next nove will be.

It is said that the defence will apply for bail and it is alleged that Thaw cannot be touched by the Immigration authorities until the charges have be n disposed of. Justice Globensky before delivering udgment, warned the public against any demonstration. He said that any one creating a scene would be seat to jail if caught in the act.


